Easy Wood Crafting Guide





Put an "X" on the front side of the pieces you will cover with paper.




Put the "X" against the back side of the paper you will use and trace it.



Paint, stain, or leave unfinished any areas not covered by paper.



While the paint is drying, cut out your paper pieces.



Apply Mod Podge or other glue to a piece with an "X" and cover with paper.



Use a paper file to cut the edge of the paper flush with the wood to create a cute, perfect finish!



* If desired you can spray your project with a clear satin or matte cover to protect it and make it shine.
