For our Thursday craft, we're sharing how we created this fun little spring/summer decor piece! Our cute mason jar with flowers is a favorite craft adn will certainly brighten your day! We hope you'll enjoy following along and share your projects with us, too!

Supplies used: Mason Jar Wood Craft Craft Paints to match your papers
Papers used: A Cherry on Top, Sweet Floral, Cut A Part and All the Yum; Cake Smash Balloon Time Paper
(I also used scraps from a graph paper for the floral centers)

A Cherry on Top Tags Pack
Twine and Baker's Twine pieces

Und Project Instructions: To start, you'll want to paint the edges of all of your wood pieces (paint them to match your paper colors)!

Next, you'll want to trace your shapes onto your patterned papers. I like to lay my paper out as if it were finished, then I flip the paper and wood piece over and trace my shape. Then you can cut out each shape to be ready to adhere to the wood.

Once your paint is dried, you can adhere your paper to the shapes. Once they are adhered, you can sand down all of the edges to finish off each piece!

Glue the pieces together as shown (floral centers to flowers, lid to top of jar, etc.)

Once I had my pieces in place, I wrapped some twine beneath the 'lid' and attached a tag & I decided to place my wooden heart piece on it as a "gift" look... you could add it right to the jar in the center, or off to the side... wherever you love it!

Last, I tied a twine piece to the tall flower for detail and that was it!
