How to work the system.

Easy 1

- 90 Degree cut out options on both ends of the system
- Connect to Easy Basin with no adapters needed
- Snap and lock connections
- Bottom outlet on end end of the system and the middle
- Schedule 40 adapters are available

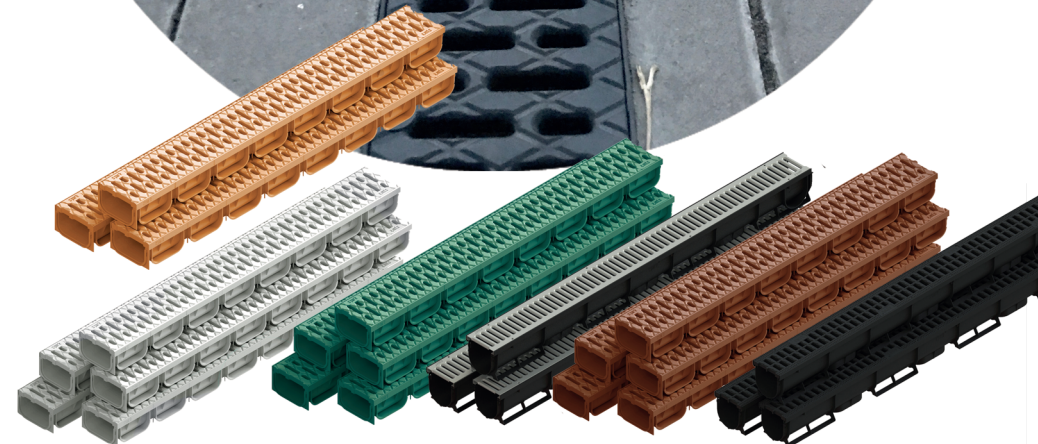
Easy 2

- 90 Degree connection options all the way down the channel
- Connect to Easy Basins with basin adapter
- Snap and lock connections channel to channel
- Bottom outlet all the way up and down the channel with included adapters in the packages.

Site Prep & Trench Set Up

Prepping your site, in our opinion, is the most crucial part of the installation of your Easy system. This is going to be the “foundation” of your system. The area that you will be working with the entire job. So make sure to go outside or inside and take a look through these steps where you are going to be installing the Easy System.

Two types of installation options are possible with the Easy system. These are - Concrete installation option, or within the grass / ground / soil.

The trench needs to be (in both cases) two to three inches or larger on both sides of the system. If you are going up against an existing foundation that is fine, but make sure on the opposing side you have two to three inches.

FAQ's

Can I drive over the Easy System?

The Easy System is a Load Class A (3,300 lb). This does not mean the system holds that amount of weight anywhere, that is the load class for the entire system. A Class is considered Pedestrian, however very light vehicles can go over it if installed in concrete.

Can I cut the channels?

Yes, you can cut the system, that is not a problem. Cut where you are not going to be connecting another channel. The end cap will then need to be sealed on that cut side of the channel.

Installation



Concrete

1. Prep the trench according to our preparation instructions
2. Line up your outlet pipe in the ground where you want to make your final connection or outlet.
3. Pour your two to three inch concrete base and level off. Let it set up to 75% hard. You still want to be able to slightly push your trench drain in there still. This is called “wet set”.
4. Set outlet pipe to channel connection whether its on the bottom or out of the end cap. Connect and lay your channel together and weigh the system down. This is to hold the channels in place so they do not move during the rest of pour or when the concrete is drying and expanding.
5. Pour concrete all around and let sit. Keep an eye on any shifts or movement in the system, although there should not be any.

Soil / Ground

1. Prep the site and the trench.
2. Place leveling sand (if preferred) in the bottom of the trench
3. Connect outlet pipe to outlet location first
4. Lay Easy system in trench, sealing the channel connections
5. Back fill with your soil / sand / or ground.

IMPORTANT It is recommended to leave the gratings in the system for both types of installations. To make sure of proper leveling and not bending or warping during drying of the concrete or pour of the soil / ground fill.
