## FIRE PIT CARE & MAINTENANCE

Your Petra Stone fire pit is constructed using only quality portland cement, aggregate, and pigments. It is designed to provide you years of enjoyment. Before assembling your fire pit, carefully prepare, lay out, and level the area your fire pit will occupy.

- Carefully follow the provided instructions.
- Some people may prefer to use a polymer enhanced (fortified) tile thin-set mortar, instead of concrete adhesive. If thin-set is used, be sure to keep it off the face of your fire pit. If you do get it on the face, wipe it off before it dries using a wet sponge or rag.
- Be careful not to chip the face of the blocks. Our fire pit blocks and caps are integrally colored so that, even if chipped, it will have the same color throughout.
- If a larger chunk is knocked off, and you wish to restore the facial color to that area, contact us directly for instructions.
- The color of our fire pit is designed to last for many years. Do not use acid or harsh chemicals to clean your fire pit. Use only a mild washing detergent and a sponge.
- To ensure a long lasting color, apply a quality concrete sealer each year.
- The fire ring is non-treated black steel and will naturally degrade over time. If you want a longer lasting ring, you may want to purchase a stainless steel ring.
- Lava rock or other porous stone should be used between the fire ring and the fire pit. This will help dissipate the heat and help give the fire pit a more distinctive look.
