TASTING NOTES (18-02-18)



THIS IS A CLEAN WINE WITH VIOLET TONES, AND CHERRY - RED IN COLOR.

A FRESH, HIGH - INTENSITY AROMA WITH STANDOUT NOTES OF FRESH RED FRUIT, LIKE RASPBERRY, CHERRY, AND PLUM.

ALSO PRESENT ARE NOTES OF LILY, GENTLE WOOD, BALSAMIC, VANILLA, BLACK LICORICE AND SPICES, MAKING IT A VERY EXPRESSIVE WINE WITH GOOD AROMATIC QUALITY.

A DRY WINE WITH JUICY ACIDITY AND WARM ALCOHOL. THE TANNINS ARE PLEASANT AND ROUND, LENDING IT A FULL BODY.

AROMAS IN THE MOUTH FEEL MORE MATURE AND INTENSE THAN ON THE NOSE, REMINISCENT OF PLUM, BLUEBERRY, STRAWBERRY JAM, CINNAMON, VANILLA, MILK CHOCOLATE, CARAMEL, COFFEE, AND WOOD. SECONDARY NOTES INCLUDE WHITE PEPPER AND EUCALYPTUS, BOOSTING THE FRESHNESS AND COMPLEXITY. VERY WELL - BALANCED WITH AN ELEGANT FINISH.

IN THE MOUTH, IT'S GENTLE, THANKS TO THE BALANCE BETWEEN THE ACIDITY, WARM ALCOHOL, AND SMOOTHNESS OF THE MATURE TANNINS. MOUTH AROMAS REMINISCENT OF THE NOSE, PLUS JUICY NOTES OF RED FRUIT, CHOCOLATE, AND MOCHA. A WELL - BALANCED WINE WITH AN EXCELLENT FINISH.
