A CLEAR AND BRIGHT WINE WITH VIOLET UNDERTONES AND AN INTENSE CHERRY - RED COLOR.

THE NOSE IS FRESH AND INTENSE. STANDOUT ARE NOTES OF DARK BERRIES, CHERRY, BLACKCURRANT, BLUEBERRY, STRAWBERRY, AND RASPBERRY, PRINCIPALLY. MARKED FLORAL NOTES OF LILY AND VIOLET. MOREOVER, THERE ARE AROMAS OF WOOD, CACAO, DAIRY, BLACK PEPPER, CLOVE, VANILLA, NUTMEG, TOAST, COFFEE BEANS, LICORICE, AND BALSAMICS. THE AROMA PROFILE IS COMPLEX AND ELEGANT.

A WINE WITH GREAT VOLUME THAT ENCOMPASSES THE ENTIRE PALATE. DRY, FRESH ACIDITY, AND WARMING ALCOHOL. TANNINS ARE SWEET, AND VERY PRESENT, LENDING IT A VELVETY BODY. MOUTH AROMAS ARE THE RED AND BLACK FRUIT, CURRANT, DAIRY, FLORALS, PICES, WOOD, SMOKE, ROASTED COFFEE BEANS, CINNAMON, CHOCOLATE, VANILLA, PEPPER, AND BLACK LICORICE.
