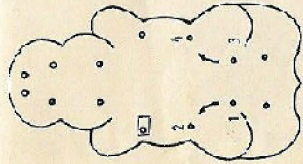
Create an entire menagerie from one snap-together shape!

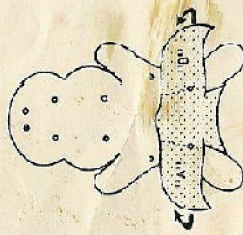

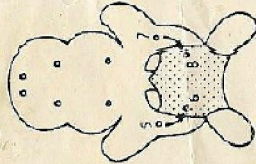

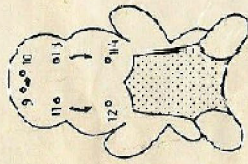
- SNAP 1 TO 2

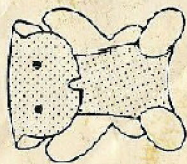
- FOLD FLAP "A" BACK TOWARD BODY AS SHOWN, FOLD FLAP "B" AROUND BEHIND FLAP "A"



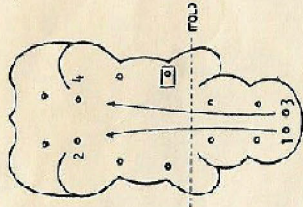
- HOLDING FOLDED FLAPS

SNAP 13 TO 14

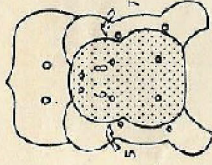


- YOU'VE JUST MADE A SNAPAZOO BEAR!

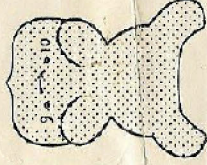

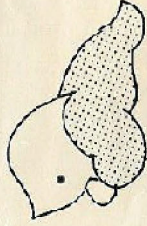
- FOLD WHERE SHOWN AS YOU

- YOU ARE NOW LOOKING AT THE UNDERSIDE OF A TORTOISE TO FORM THE FRONT LEGS

SNAP 7 TO 8



- TURN SNAPAZOO OVER AND

TO MAKE THE TORTOISE'S
HEAD



- THE TORTOISE YOU HAVE JUST MADE HAS A GREAT HIDING PLACE INSIDE!

THIS ELEPHANT IS A VERY CLOSE COUSIN OF THE BEAR. SEE IF YOU CAN FIGURE OUT HOW ONE TURNS INTO THE OTHER. (HINT: THE BEAR'S PAWS BECOME THE ELEPHANT'S EARS, AND JULY BOTH HAVE THE SAME BOTTOM LEGS.)

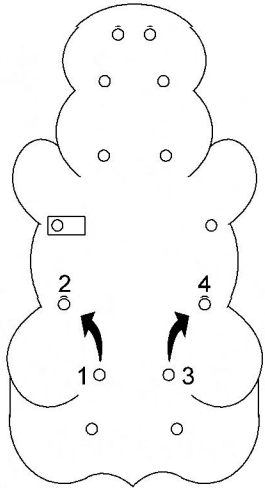
WE HOPE YOU HAVE FUN DISCOVERING ALL THE DIFFERENT CREATURES HIDING IN YOUR SNAPAZOO TOY - WE'VE FOUND OVER 25 SO FAR. To clean your SNAPAZOO TOY, surface wash with a mild soap and air dry.

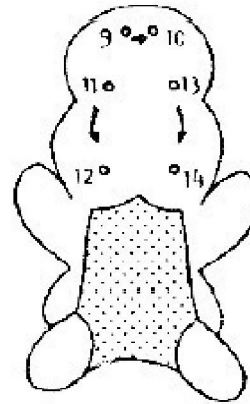
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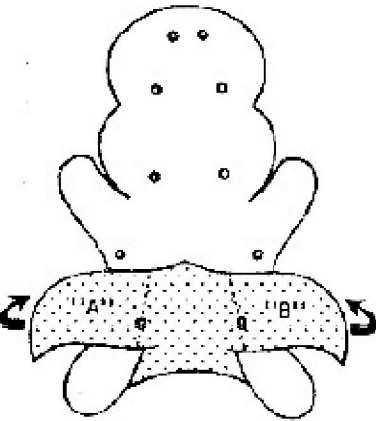

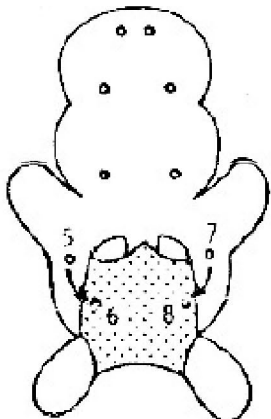
SNAP 9 TO 10 TO FORM NOSE

"B" AROUND BEHIND FLAP "A"

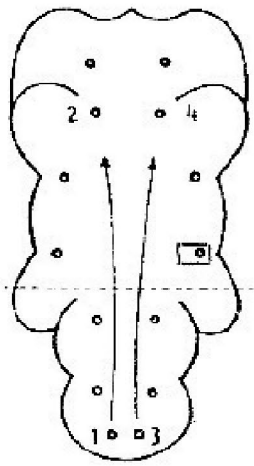


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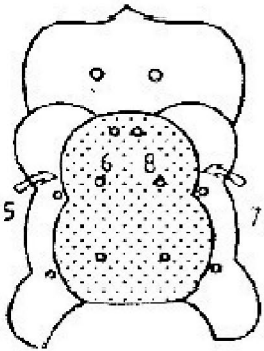

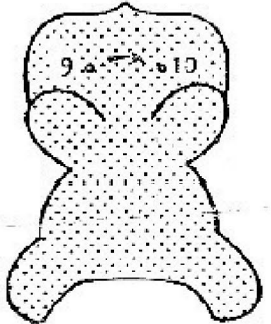


LAY UNSNAPPED SNAPAZOO

(My Version)

16 inches when finished

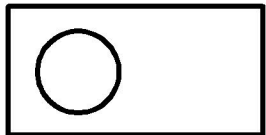
Use 1/8 inch seams or as close to it as you can get, for the best results.

Tape the 2 pattern pieces together at the dotted line.

Use 2 different colors of Fleece, cut on the outside lines only. The lines forming the "arms" and "legs" will be cut after they are sewn.

Detail stitching lines

around cutting line



Mark snap placements on the right side of one piece.

Mark the cutting lines for the "arms" and "legs" on the wrong side of one piece (so you can see it to sew around it).



Pin Right sides together, (use a lot of pins, you'll be glad you did).



Sew using 1/8 inch seams.

(See *Details for sewing around the "arms" and "legs".

*Sew down one side, turn, make 2 stitches, turn and sew up the other side.) For "legs", round the pointy end.

Leave a 2 - 3 inch gap on one side to turn it right-side out through.



Cut the line between the stitching.

Turn it right-side out and smooth out all the seams.

Hand sew gap closed.



Place your snaps using the *Guide* page.

Ta-Da, all done. Now you can play with it!
