



CONGRATULATIONS! You are now the proud owner of a pair of **Chicago** 1900 Series Roller Skates. Much time and effort went into the development and manufacture of these skates to provide you a high quality skate which needs very little adjustment or special care. In order to protect you from injury as well as add to the life of your skates a few simple precautions must be taken. Refer to diagram for location and parts.

CHECK WHEEL ADJUSTMENT

Ideally, there ought to be very little skate or play on the wheels. Make the adjustment by either loosening or tightening the axle nut. This is a self-locking nut and in most cases need not be adjusted. If the axle nut is removed for any reason, it must be replaced by a new one. The Lock Nut Must Be Tight Against the Plate At All Time To Prevent Damage.

LUBRICATE YOUR SKATES REGULARLY

Oil ball bearings once or twice each month, or as needed, with one drop of oil each side of wheel. If a precision bearing is used a periodic greasing is recommended.

NOTE:

These bearings should be cleaned periodically with any oil dissolving solvent, dried and reoiled.

⚠ Caution: Check all Nuts and Screws to make sure they are tight before and after skating. If Nuts are Loose Do Not Skate until tightening them.

****TAKE CARE of your "Chicago" 1900 Series Skates**

1. Keep Skates in a dry place;
2. If skates get wet, wipe them carefully and lubricate wheels as described above;
3. We recommend stopping with the composition wheels by dragging the toe stop;
4. Clean and polish your shoes regularly. For longer wear, treat shoes with a clean cloth.

REMEMBER A LITTLE CARE PREVENTS ACCIDENTS AND PROLONGS THE LIFE OF YOUR SKATES.

IMPORTANT

If you should encounter any problems with your Chicago Skates Please follow the below procedures

Wrong Size- Please contact the company whether it be an Internet Seller or Store where you bought them and ask for an exchange. This can only be done before using the skates outside. If they are used no exchange will be allowed.

If you bought them On Line be sure to have available the Sales Order Number, Order Number or Purchase Order Number which will be on the packing slip placed on the outer carton. They should be able to help you with an exchange.

Defective Product- Please contact the company whether it be an Internet Seller or Store where you bought them and ask for an exchange if within the Warranty Period

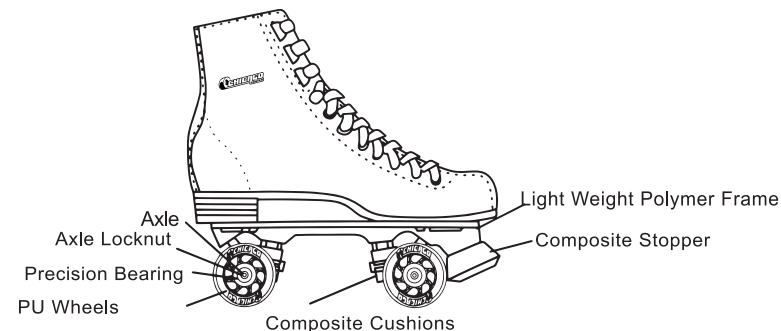
