

MINISTRY OF DISCIPLESHIP KEY INGREDIENTS TO EFFECTIVE RELATIONAL DISCIPLESHIP

- Speaking truth in love (Eph. 4:15).
- Pace the relationship.
- Not programmatic but practical and flexible.
- Non-judgemental and safe.
- Listen, not to answer but to understand.
- A mixture of humility, authenticity, wisdom, experience, and truth.
- Keep confidences trust is essential.
- Jesus as the model for character development.
