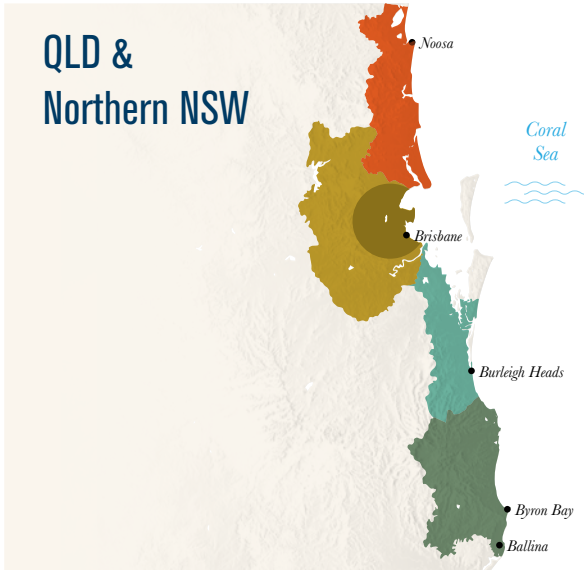

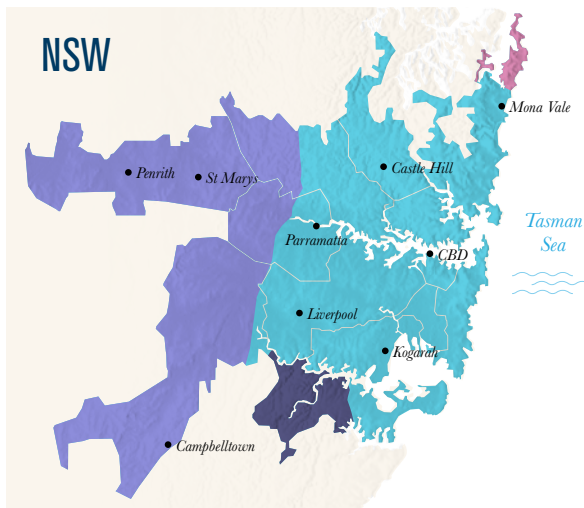

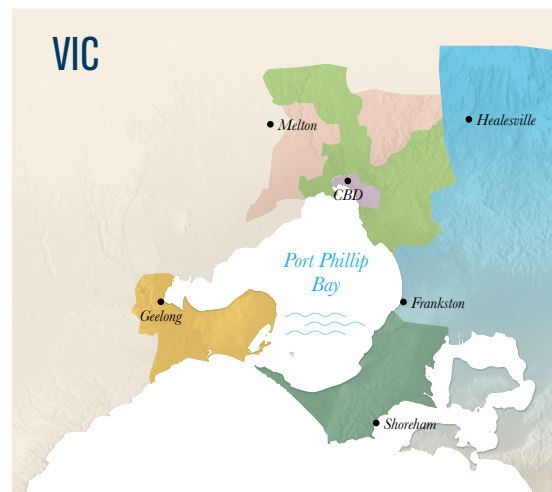

I was travelling through America in 2018, where I spent a couple of nights with an old friend. A noted wine collector, he introduced me to what he called, "the best wine glasses, full-stop". I kept marvelling at the fine, elegant stemware - with the main feature being a unique "double-bend", creating something like a combination of the austere, refined Zalto glass, and the classic, curvy shape of Riedel.

As you'd expect, these are hand-blown with the finest quality lead-free crystal, and therefore withstand clouding. These are made to order, so we are lucky to have access to them periodically.

I would encourage you to discover them, they are simply the finest glasses I have used in my career with wine.

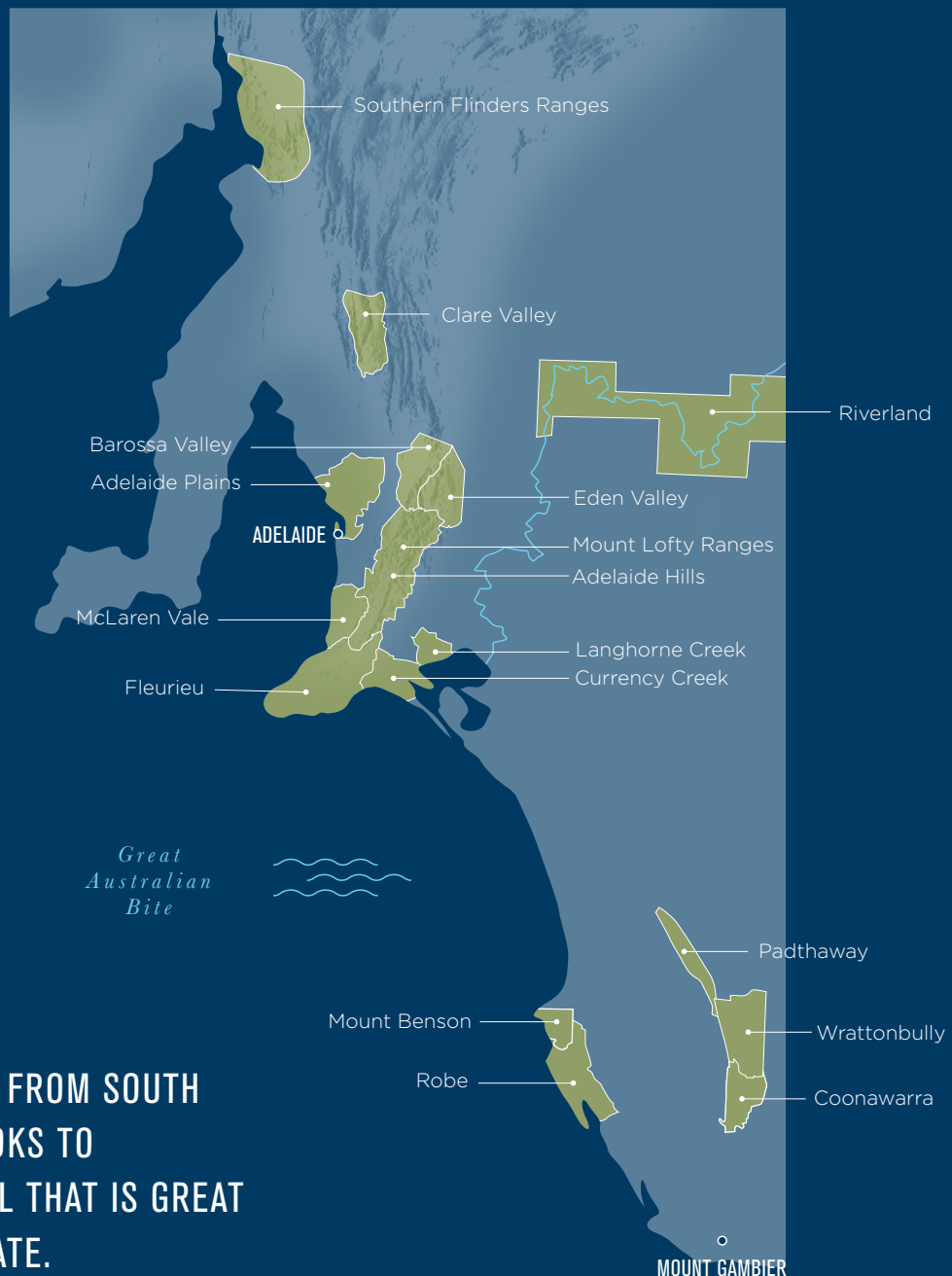

BAROSSA

South Australia



Barossa continues to be the reference point many people use when they try to define Australian wine. In general, it is a warm continental climate that is perfect for ripening its hero variety of Shiraz, but it also has a number of sloping hills and traverse valleys that create cooler pockets, especially on the edges and in the north of the region.

Many of the most important and influential wineries of the last century have either started, or have extensive holdings, in the region. Like much of Australia, the last decade or so has seen the emergence of a new generation that sees the region's identity as being more fluid and complex than the traditional styles have promoted.

We believe we offer a true picture of the region via our established winery Sons of Eden, the distinctive property of Barr-Eden Estate, alongside the newer Brave Souls project.

PARKER ESTATE

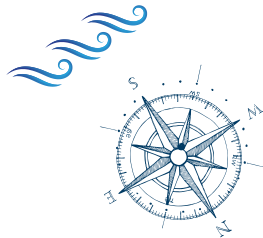
ABBAY VINEYARD

Coonawarra, SA

Situated at the Southern end of Coonawarra's famed 'cigar strip' of terra rossa soils, Parker Estate's prime position places it in a viticultural 'holy trinity' of climate, location and soil.

Once the ocean floor, the ancient soils of the South-East have been created over millions of centuries. As geological activity caused land masses to rise, the ocean retreated westward, revealing the 'Limestone Coast' of today, and the distinctive rust-red soils over limestone that have come to define the wines of Coonawarra.

This geology and climatic conditions have led to the often-made comparison to Bordeaux, one that highlights the timeless, classic and elegant style of wines from Coonawarra, especially Cabernet Sauvignon, the 'hero' variety of the region.



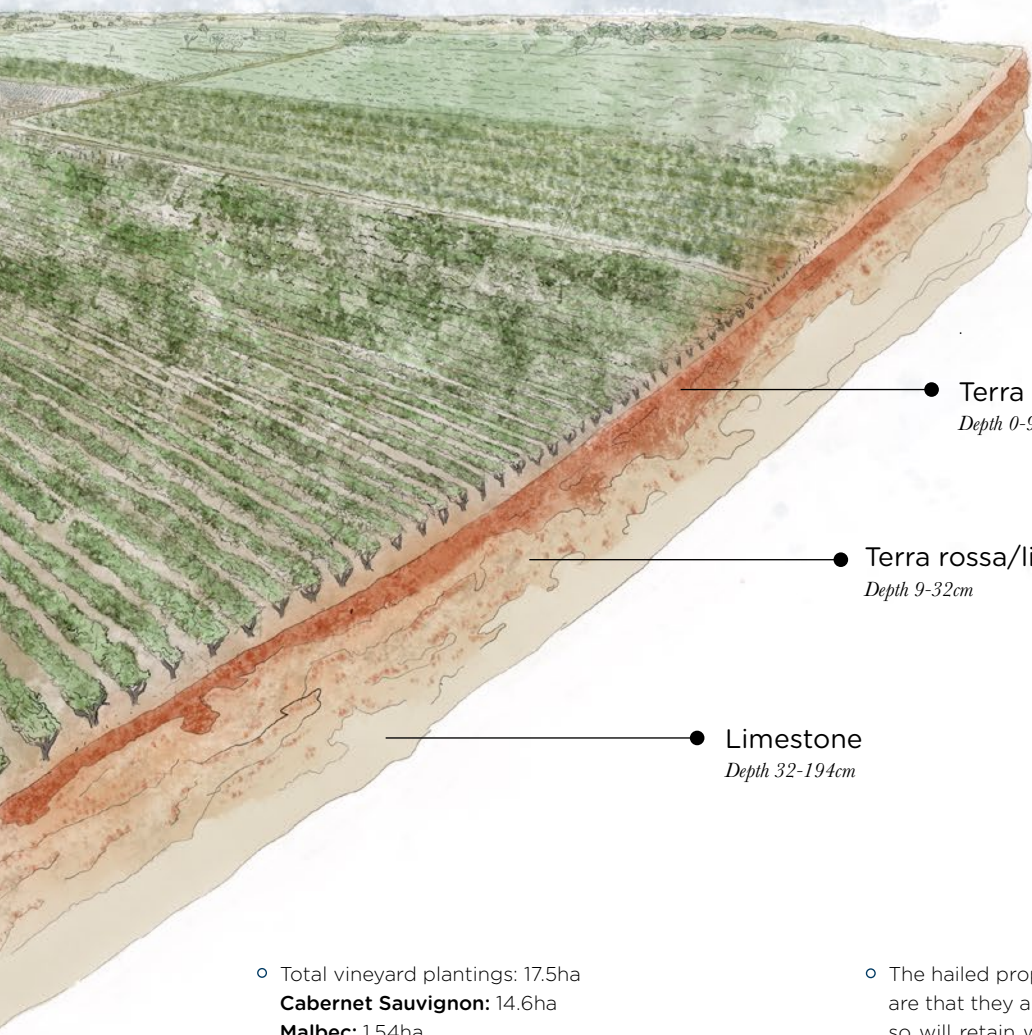
60km to Southern Ocean

The Abbey Vineyard has a moderate maritime climate. Cold winters and warm summers with a mediterranean influence of breezes from the Southern Ocean that keep the fruit cool overnight.

The soil profile sees terra rossa clay over limestone, the latter which starts at varying depths between 9-194cm throughout the vineyard:

● Terra rossa aeolian clay
Depth 0-9cm

● Terra rossa/limestone
Depth 9-32cm

● Limestone
Depth 32-194cm

- Total vineyard plantings: 17.5ha
Cabernet Sauvignon: 14.6ha
Malbec: 1.54ha
Cabernet Franc: 1.04ha
Petit Verdot: 0.32ha

- All Cabernet Sauvignon plantings are Reynell selection - cuttings sourced from 19th century-planted vines at Reynella in 1985 and probably derived from the first 1837 imports of pre-phylloxera Cabernet Sauvignon taken from Bordeaux.
- The more shallow terra rossa layer has high nutrient content, namely iron oxide (gives its red colour), calcium (from limestone) & silica. The deeper limestone includes variable, complex, ancient layers of calcium carbonate.

- The hailed properties of limestone for grape-growing are that they are free-draining when wet, and porous, so will retain water in dry periods (a supplementary source of water). They are nutrient-rich, providing distinctive minerality to the wines.

- To conserve the integrity of the ancient soils, permanent grasses are sown to encourage nutrient recycling, pest control, organic matter production, and biological activity.

- Typically a very long and slow growing season (average 220-240 days) - ideal for Cabernet. Harvest usually starts in mid-April, which can often be up to 2 weeks after sites at the northern end of Coonawarra.

BARR-EDEN ESTATE

Barr-Eden Estate is a storied piece of land situated at the crest of Mengler's Hill, one of the highest points of viticulture in Australia. Well-known grape-grower Joel Mattschoss first acquired fruit from the site, which sits atop the ancient goldfields of the Eden, in 2014, to produce the first small batch Love Over Gold wine with Frenchman Pierre-Henri Morel. After the passing of the estate's owner, Barossa icon, Bob McLean, in 2015, a venture began between the two, along with friends Michael Twelftree and Tim Hower, to become the new custodians of this special property of great pedigree.

Sourcing fruit from a single vineyard in the Blewitt Springs sub-region of McLaren Vale. Organic-in-conversion, this sandy vineyard has been completely re-imagined since being purchased by the brothers in 2009. Planting and grafting over southern Mediterranean varietals has seen them create a unique range of blends alongside some classic and SO2-free Shiraz.

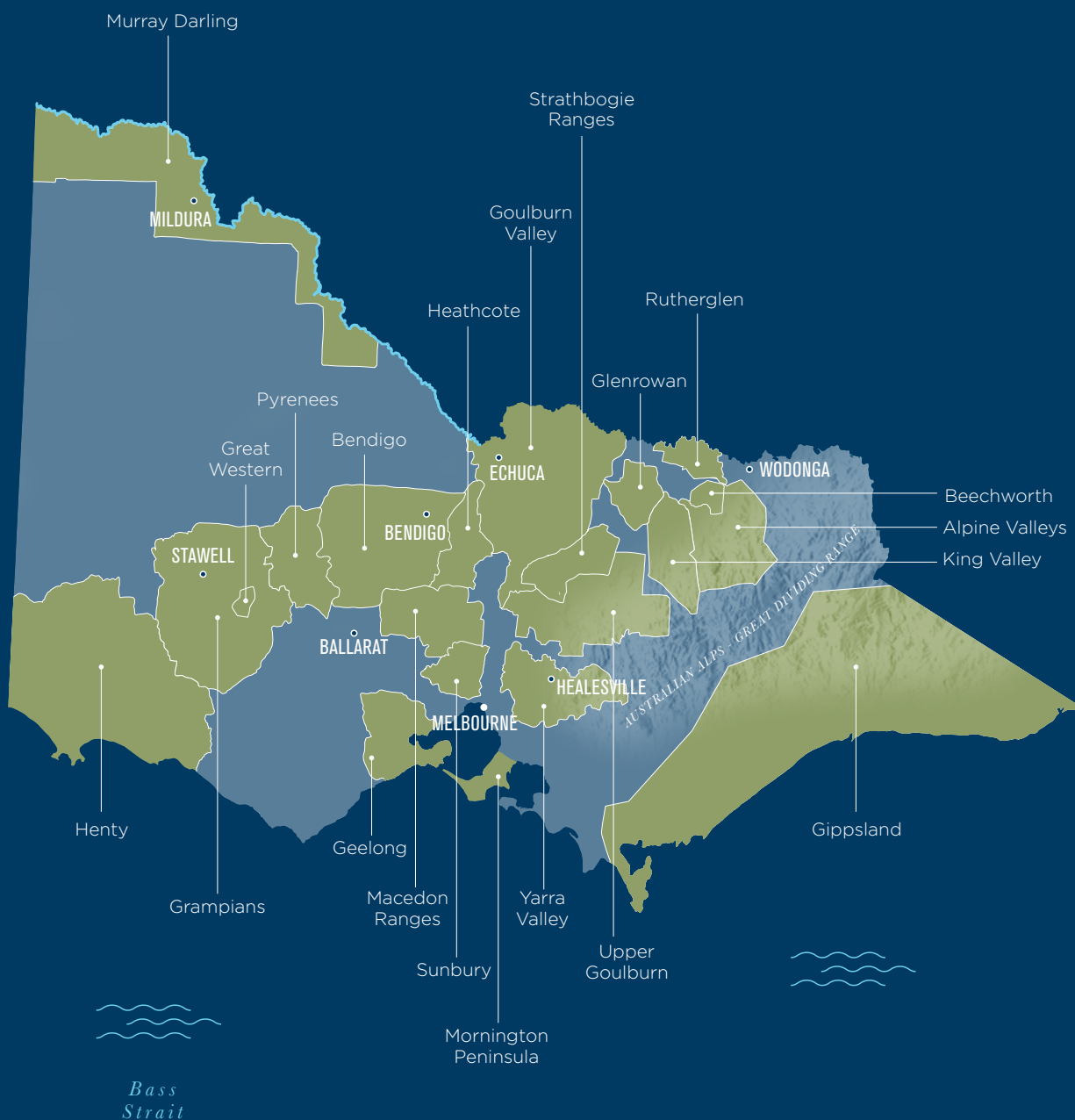

Wines by region

For a state that came to viticulture relatively late, Western Australia has played an outsized role in the emergence of fine wine in Australia.

We must start with Margaret River. Although it came to prominence no more than 40 years ago, it is firmly entrenched in the perception of quality, prestige and scarcity.

When Mark Fesq first started representing Mike Peterkin's Pierro label in 1988, it was to be the first of his bottles sold on the east coast. Not long after, we began a relationship with two other great, family businesses, Leeuwin Estate and Moss Wood (1993 and 1989).

MARGARET RIVER

Western Australia

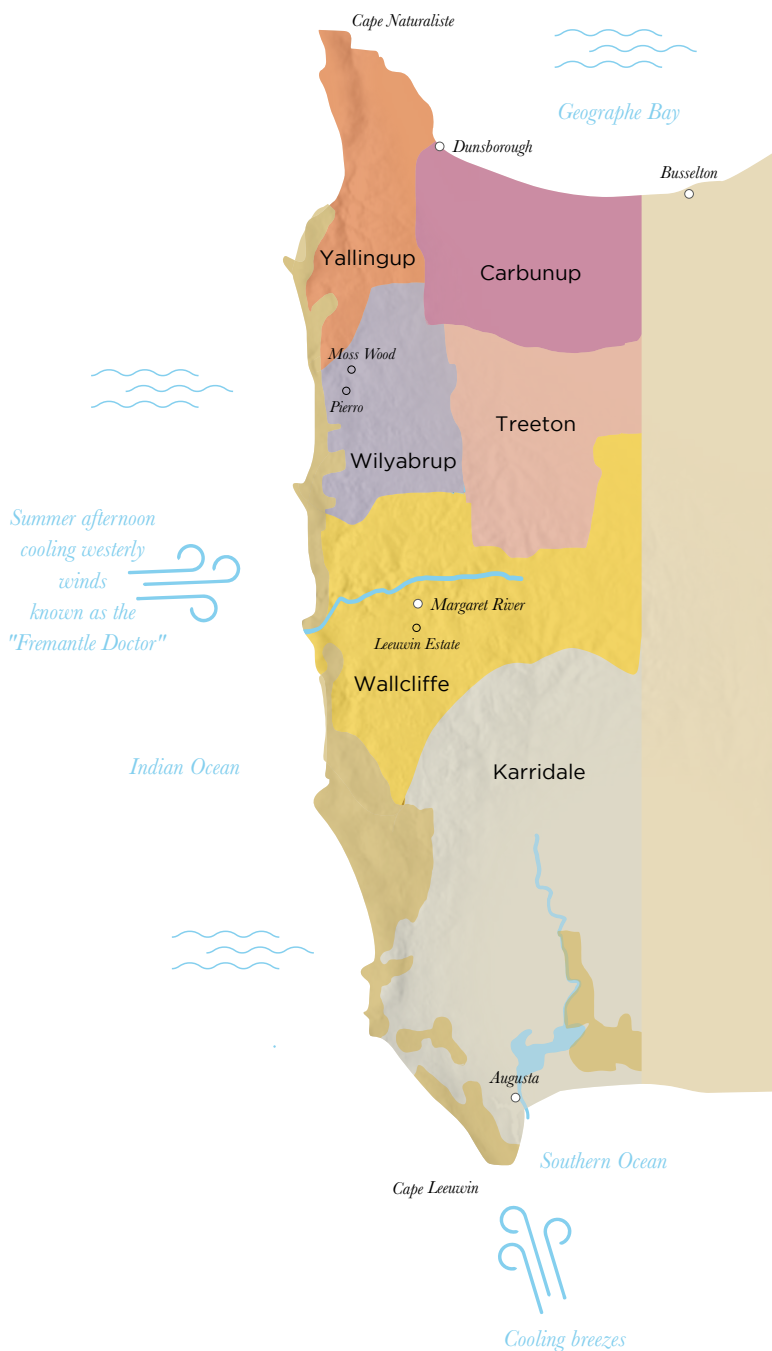
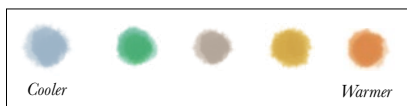
The Margaret River region is a maritime influenced climate made up of mostly boutique sized wineries. It produces a scant 3% of the wine in Australia, but makes up a very significant portion of the premium production.

Being over 100km long, and 30km wide, it has a broad range of mesoclimates that avoid easy characterisation. Many of the famed whites come from the centre and south, whilst cabernet tends to ripen earlier in the north. That said, many of the iconic Chardonnays, such as Pierro and Moss Wood, come from Wilyabrup, whilst the Cabernet of Wallcliffe is certainly considered as fine as any other part of the region.

There has recently been a passionate discussion around whether to push sub-regionality more assertively, particularly from a group of wineries in Wilyabrup. It is a healthy debate that will likely lead to ongoing research into the differences within the region.

Consistent quality: Margaret River's sustained vintage success

It has become cliché to speak of Margaret River's long string of excellent vintages, but it does speak to the region's optimal climatic conditions – the moderating ocean breezes on three sides, abundant sunshine, good rainfall that falls mostly in winter and low diurnal and seasonal temperature variation that provides an evenness of warmth. In the past decade or more, extraordinary quality has been a consistent charm; a reliable and envious reputation. To take a snapshot of the past five vintages; some slightly cooler and wetter ('21 possibly impacted by La Nina on the East coast), others being marginally warmer and drier; a 'classic' season has emerged of a mild-to-warm West Coast Indian Summer extending harvest into April. Commentary on yields - bird pressure and Marri flowering - are nearly always a factor and can have significant impact on the final harvest size (notably in '20). Overall however, it's considered the most stable growing conditions of any in Australia.

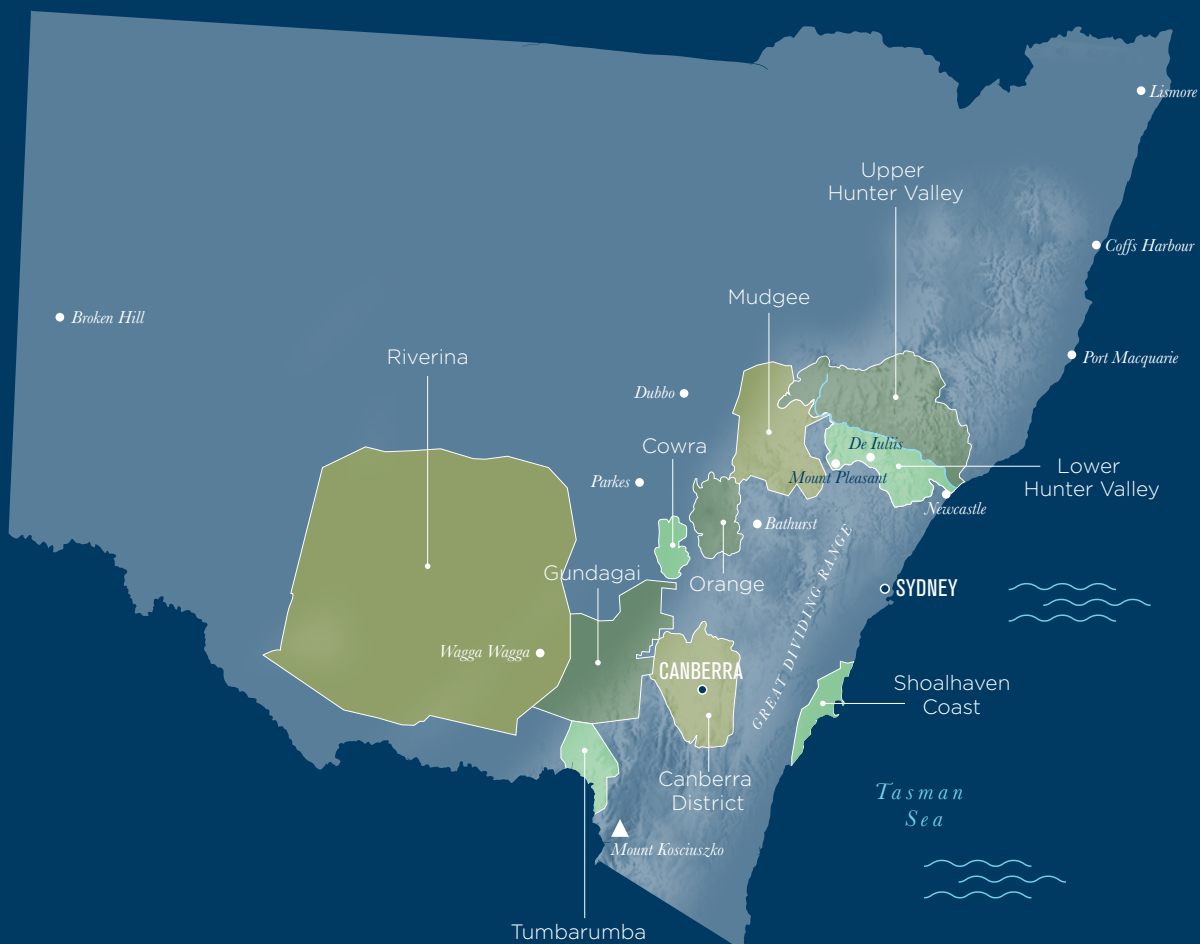

Wines by region



New South Wales is the oldest wine producing state in Australia, with the Hunter Valley being Sydney's "backyard" region.

Always unique, the specialties of Semillon, Verdelho and fine, medium-bodied Shiraz have made Hunter an idiosyncratic region, and all the more special for it. The icon of Mount Pleasant – its place in Australian wine history and the rare, ancestral vines on the estate – is a jewel in the industry. DE IULIIS LOVEDALE ROAD VINEYARD

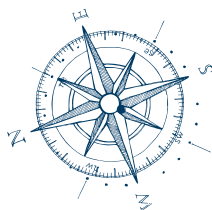
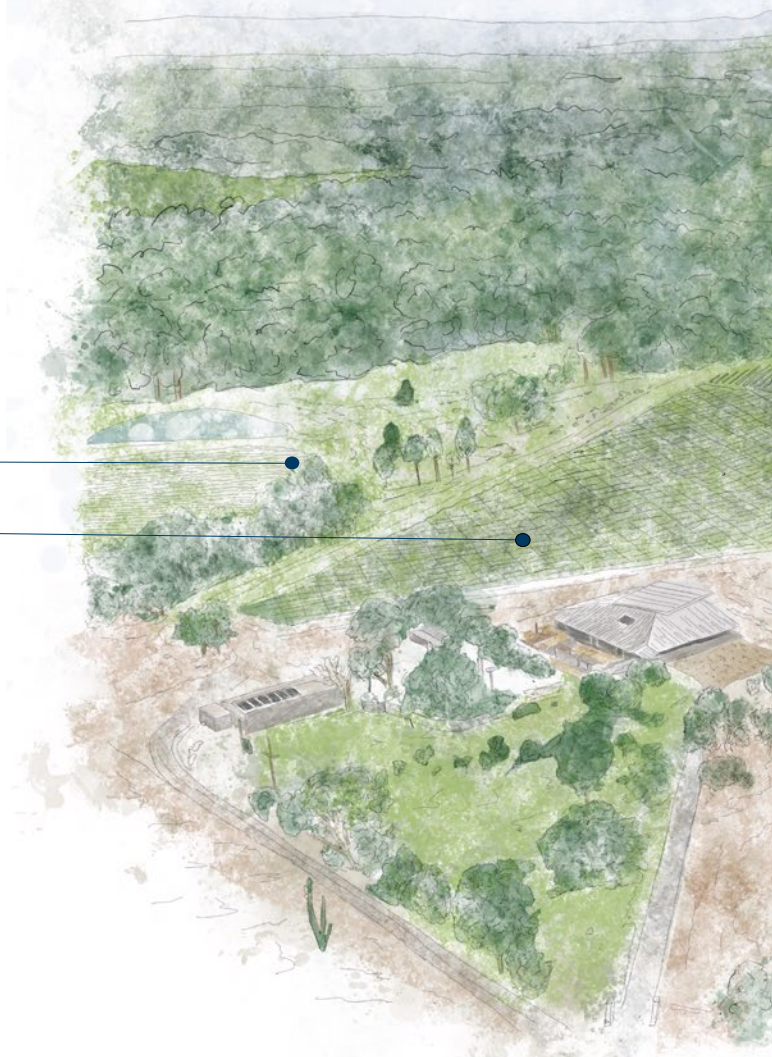
Hunter Valley, NSW

The De Iuliis family purchased a 40-acre cattle grazing property on the Hunter Valley's famed Lovedale Road in 1987. Inspired by their origins in Abruzzo, Italy, their vision was always to make wine, so they spent a few years restoring the land and then began to plant vines, starting with the classic Hunter heroes: Semillon, Chardonnay, Shiraz, Merlot and Verdelho. Since then, the 'new guard' in Mike De Iuliis has brought the winery into a new era, planting new varietals and introducing innovative practices. It's a vineyard that tells the story of a passionate family business, built from the ground up and evolving over time.

The LDR Vineyard is a heavy clay soil throughout. It is farmed utilising regenerative agricultural techniques such as the use of BioChar. Lovedale as a subregion is quite sheltered from harsh weather events and the thick tree line around the vineyard also assists with this.

0.7 ha of Touriga Nacional was planted in 2010. Along with Tempranillo and Montepulciano, these are Mediterranean varieties suited to the Hunter climate with thick skins that have a strong resistance to disease and drought.

3 ha of Shiraz planted in 1991 that came from cuttings of the Mount Pleasant Old Hill Vineyard. They are planted on the northern slope to take advantage of full sun exposure and optimise flavour ripeness. The De Iuliis LDR Shiraz is a blend of the best barrels selected from the various Shiraz blocks and clones throughout the vineyard.





1.5 ha McWilliams heritage Shiraz clone first planted in the Hunter in 1920, grafted in 2018.

0.4 ha of Tempranillo was transplanted here from another vineyard in 2018. Transplanting is not common practice in viticulture, and Mike and Joss were told it would fail, but now they are harvesting sensational fruit from these monstrously tall vines each season.

2.9 ha of Chardonnay was planted in 1990 in east-west rows for the canopy to provide effective shade in the growing season.

1.5 ha of McWilliams heritage Shiraz clone was first planted in the Hunter in 1920 and was grafted here in 2018.

3.2 ha of Semillon was planted in 1990. The heavy clay soil produces vibrant and aromatic, approachable, young Semillon.

0.4 ha of Steven Shiraz clone was first planted in 1968 and grafted here in 2010. De luliis purchased the Steven Vineyard in 2013 after leasing it for a number of years.

0.8 ha of Montepulciano was planted in 2014 as a homage to the De luliis family origins in Abruzzo where it is the hero native red variety of the region.

TASMANIA

Wines by region

Tasmania has seen perhaps the most rapid transformation of any state in the industry in recent years. Plantings now cover almost twice the area they did a decade ago.

Tasmania's reputation on the world stage, particularly in the premium sparkling category, has seen an equally quick ascension. This has been driven by a number of reasons, but chief among them are recent consumer trends towards sparkling wines, Pinot Noir and aromatic whites, especially Pinot Gris. Today we see Tasmania as one of the few parts of Australia where demand outstrips supply, cementing its status as a cool-climate, premium designation. In the pursuit of balance and expression of terroir, Tasmania is a leading light.

The Bream Creek vineyard was planted in 1974 by Fred Peacock. One of the first commercial vineyards established in the Apple Isle state, it has long been considered one of the very best sites in Eastern Tasmania. Fred's premium cool-climate wines are concentrated and long, thanks to the mature vines and low yields.

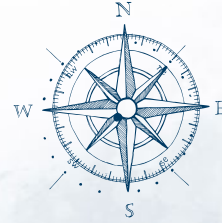

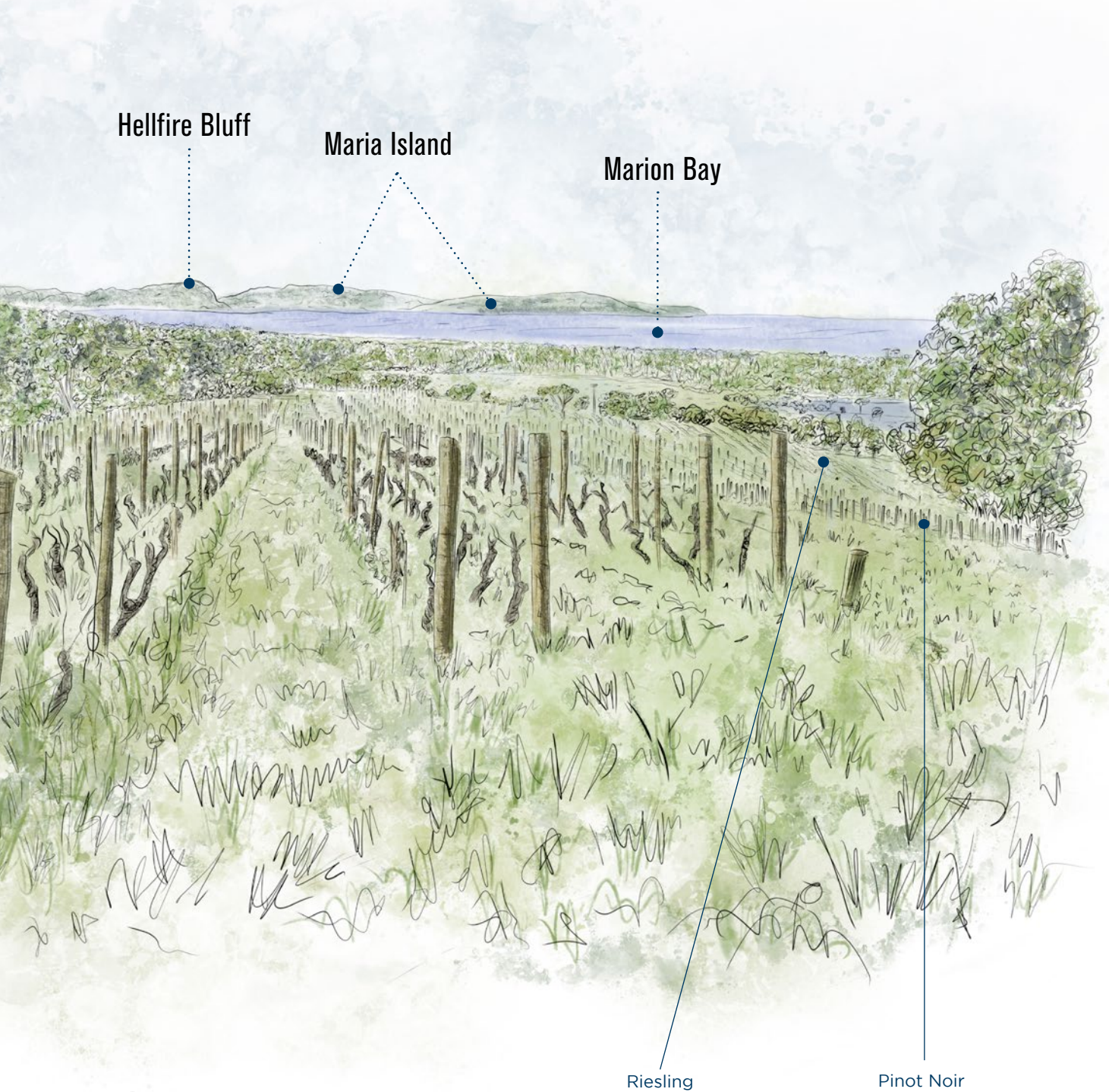
BREAM CREEK VINEYARD

Marion Bay, TAS

Bream Creek Vineyard was planted in 1974 on Tasmania's East Coast in the Bream Creek district. Being the oldest commercial vineyard on Tassie's East Coast, this vineyard has seen enormous changes in not only vineyard systems but also due to the warming climate.



- o The original Pinot Noir plantings date back to 1974.
- o The “old block” of Riesling vines were planted in 1974 when the climate was much cooler, so in line with the theory of the day the vines are very close to the ground to avoid the cooler sea breezes. As their roots are so deep now, this old Riesling block no longer needs irrigating.
- o Bream Creek Vineyard is planted on a north easterly facing slope and receives the first rays of the sun to warm the soil. With its east to north east aspect, the vineyard is also sheltered from the strongest prevailing winds which normally blow from the westerly quarter.
- o Being close to the sea, Bream Creek Vineyard avoids the heavier rains due to its low altitude, although on very rare occasions winter snow has fallen in the vineyard.
- o Bream Creek Vineyard has quite an extensive range of varieties including Riesling, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc - and the rare northern German grapevine, Schönburger. The vineyard has the ability to not only produce elegant sparkling wines but also stunning Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Due to the milder climate the wines benefit from the extended slow ripening conditions.



NEW ZEALAND

Wines by region

It's no surprise, at least in retrospect, that New Zealand took to wine late, yet over-achieved in just about every area on the world stage.

Peregrine in Central Otago is a rigorously managed estate in one of the most esteemed Pinot Noir -producing regions in the world.

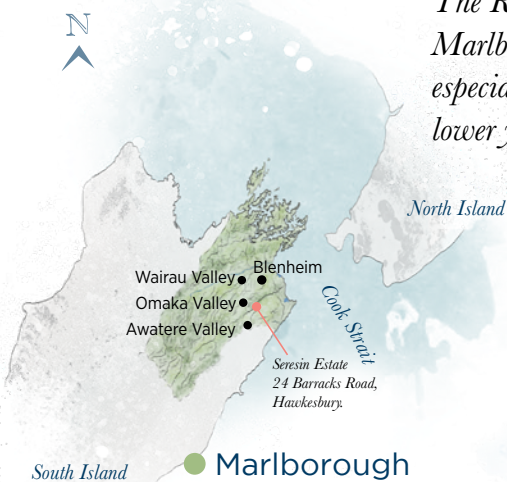


SERESIN RAUPO CREEK VINEYARD

Marlborough, NZ



The Raupo Creek vineyard is planted in the southern valleys of the Omaka Valley in Marlborough. This clay rich area is considered the finest in the region for Pinot Noir, especially, but also for concentrated flavours in the white bottlings - producing much lower yields than elsewhere in the region.



Osip Hill (highest point 150m). Gentle rolling hills provide different soils and aspects, contributing to a variety of characteristics in the fruit.

The hills have a heavier clay soil, whereas the flats (where the whites tend to be planted) are finer, sandy and silt loams with slightly less clay content.

Organics and Biodynamics

Olive groves and cover crops are sown with a mix of clovers, wild flowers and tap root species to improve soil structure, moisture retention and encourage the benefits of insects and overall biodiversity.

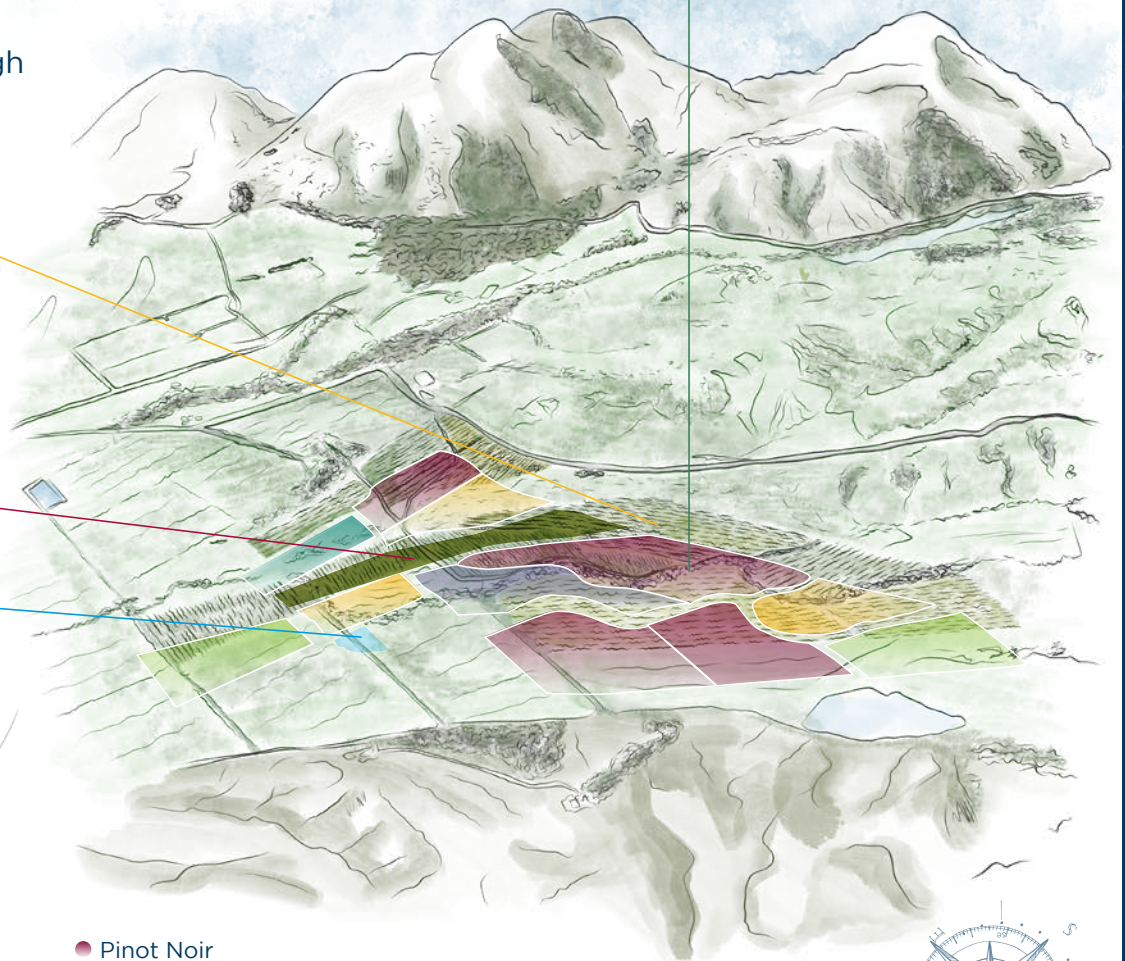
Wild yeasts are used as well as fermenting portions separately to give pure expressions of the vineyard that can then be used creatively in the blending process.

Pasture land for livestock (cows, sheep and goats) to produce their own manure and other biodynamic preparations.

Vegetable, fruit gardens and biodynamic preparation area for feeding their soils, plants and animals. As well as composts and mulches, biodynamic preparations made on the farm include chamomile flower heads, stinging nettle tea leaves, oak park and dandelion flower heads.

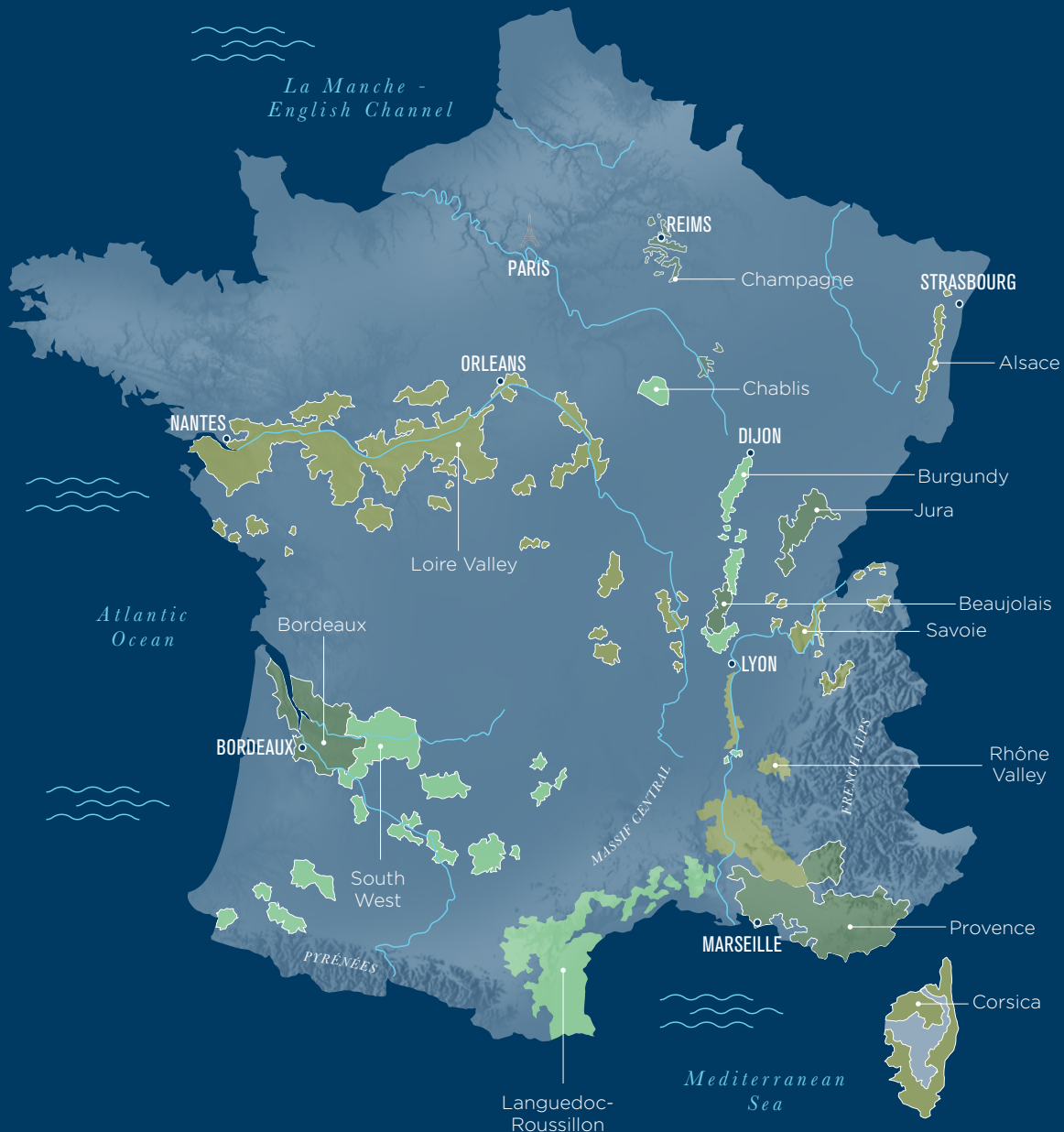

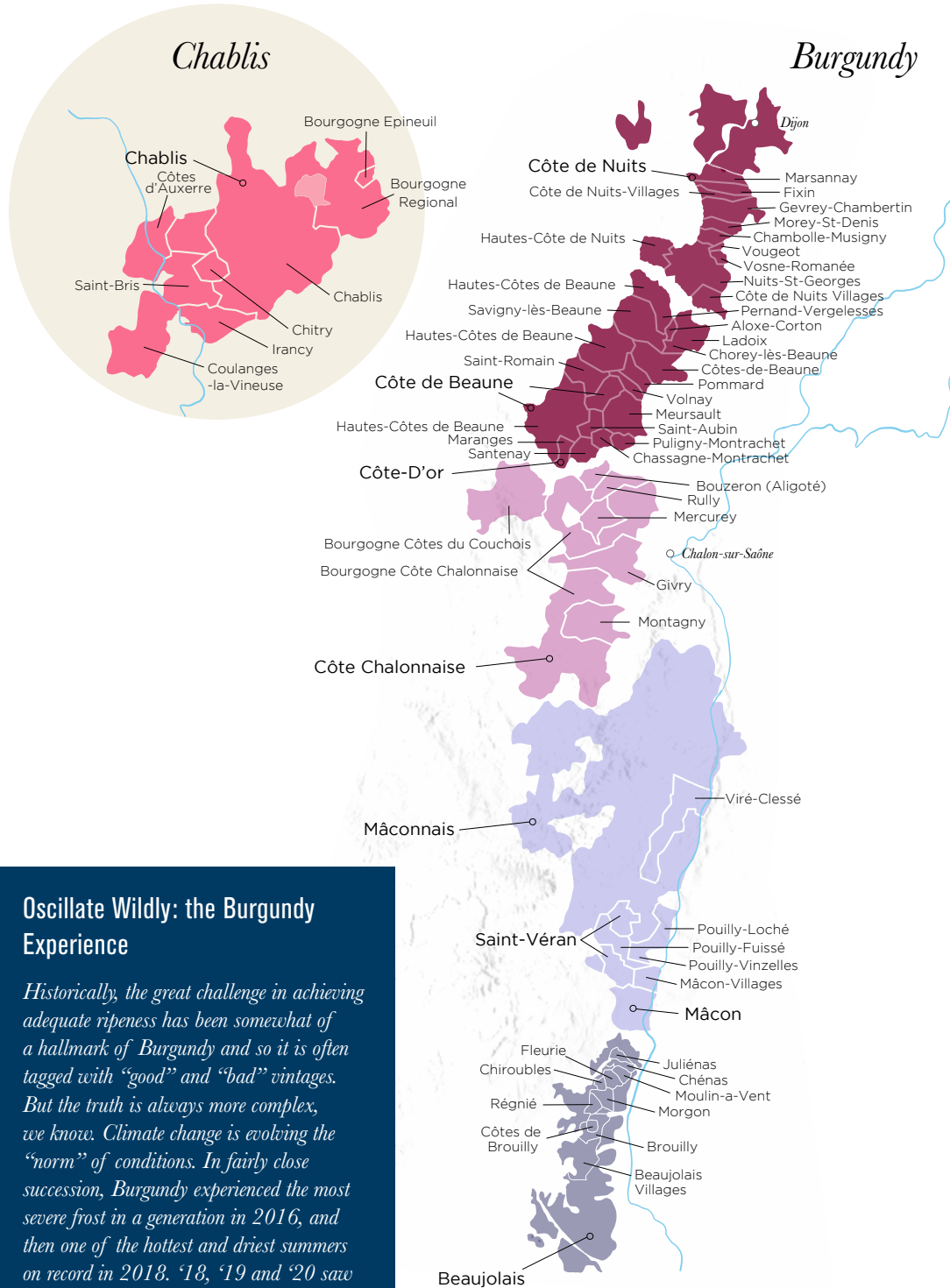

Oscillate Wildly: the Burgundy Experience

Historically, the great challenge in achieving adequate ripeness has been somewhat of a hallmark of Burgundy and so it is often tagged with “good” and “bad” vintages. But the truth is always more complex, we know. Climate change is evolving the “norm” of conditions. In fairly close succession, Burgundy experienced the most severe frost in a generation in 2016, and then one of the hottest and driest summers on record in 2018. ‘18, ‘19 and ‘20 saw a string of warm seasons ideal for ripening, but heat spikes and dry conditions (‘19) bring their own challenges. ‘21 is considered a return to a ‘classic’, cooler Burgundy vintage, and followed by a warmer ‘22. The ability to adapt and stay on one’s toes is ever the test for winemakers.

The name 'Auvigue' was already known in 1629 in the vineyards of Beaujolais and Mâconnais. Today, the grapes come from family estates covering 6 hectares including 2 that have been organically farmed for over 20 years in the Mâcon-Soltré and Pouilly-Fuissé appellations. To allow each parcel to present the unique microclimates, Jean-Pierre and Michel Auvigue always adapt the vinification process to the requirement of each plot. The wines are only lightly filtered before being bottled to retain all the elements required for the development of their true Burgundian nature.

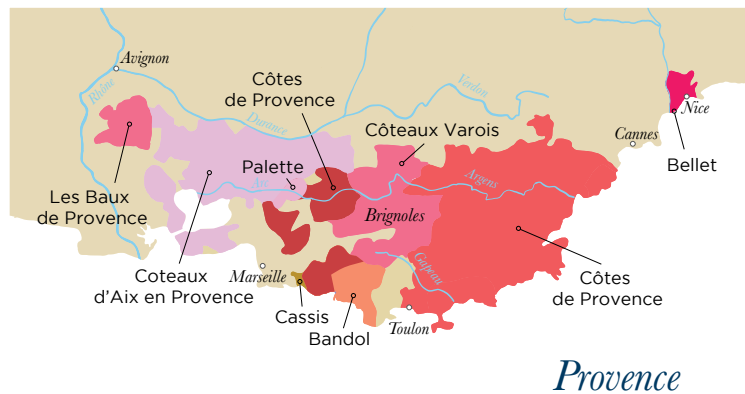
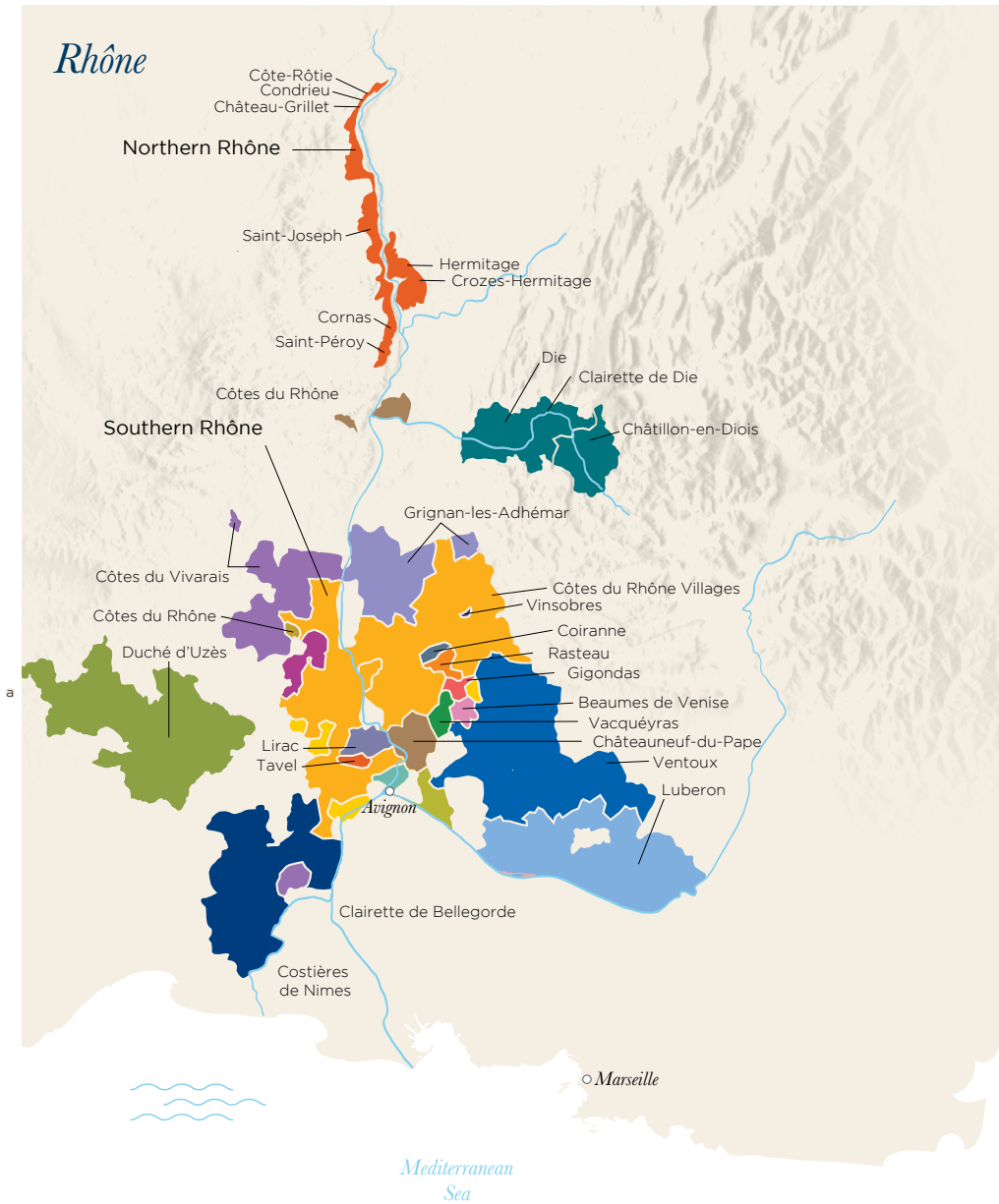

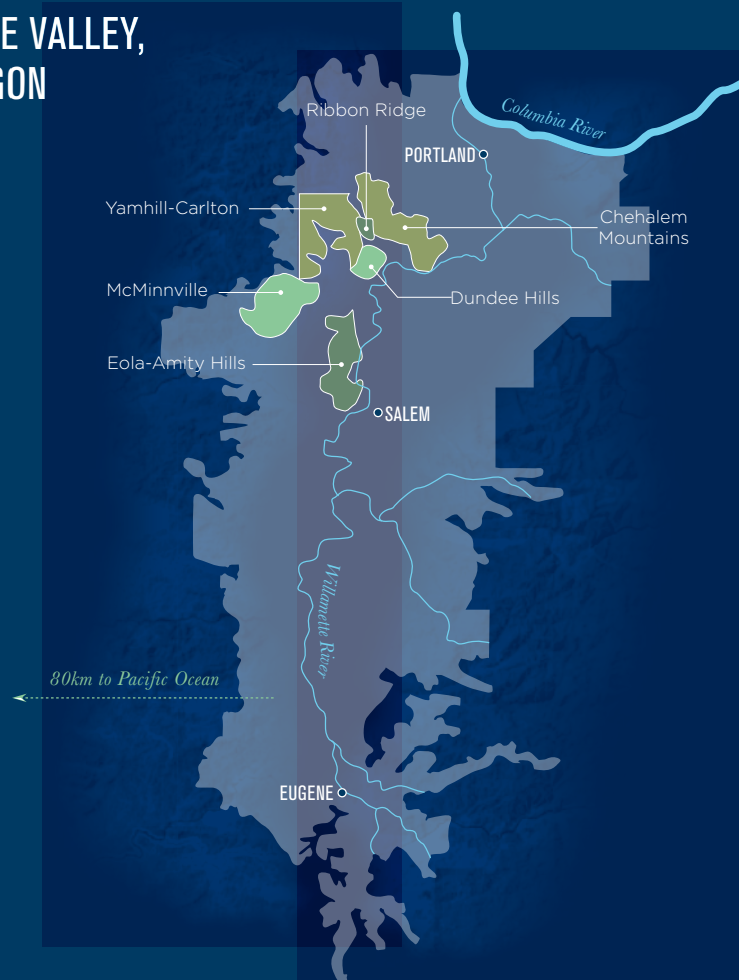

If the Customer fails to make payments on the due date, Cottenham may, in addition to taking any other action : (a) charge interest on all overdue payments at two per centum (2%) per month from the due date until the date of payment; in order to offset the cost of financing the overdue account, and (b) suspend all further delivery of goods or further performance of any other contract with the Customer. The Customer shall pay Cottenham's costs arising out of & incurred by reason of the Customer's default.

PALLETS

Pallets supplied with the goods are not sold and do not become the property of the Customer. Pallets must be exchanged at point of delivery.

PASSING OF PROPERTY

All legal and beneficial rights of ownership, property and title to all goods ("the Goods") supplied by Cottenham shall remain with Cottenham irrespective of the Customer taking possession of the Goods, and no such rights of ownership, property or title to the Goods supplied by Cottenham shall pass to the Customer unless and until the Customer has paid for the Goods by cleared funds. In addition, where at the time of paying for the Goods the Customer is indebted to Cottenham in relation to other goods ("the Other Goods"), all legal and beneficial rights of ownership, property and title to the Goods shall remain with Cottenham irrespective of the Customer taking possession of the Goods, and no such rights of ownership, property or title to Goods supplied by Cottenham shall pass to the Customer, unless and until the Customer has paid for the Other Goods by cleared funds or sells the Goods to a third party in the ordinary course of business. The Customer shall be entitled to sell the Goods in good faith in the ordinary course of business provided that in the case of the Goods referred to above the Customer shall hold and sell the Goods as trustee and fiduciary bailee and agent for Cottenham and the gross proceeds of such sale shall be held as bare trustee for Cottenham. The proceeds of sale of any goods shall be kept in a separate account and shall not be mixed with any other monies.

At any time after giving twenty four hours written notice to the Customer, Cottenham shall be entitled to enter upon the Customer's premises during normal working hours to inspect the Goods. The Goods shall be stored separately and in a manner to enable them to be identified and cross-referenced to particular invoices. If payment for the Goods is not made by the Customer to Cottenham within seven days of the due date the Customer shall deliver the Goods to Cottenham on demand. In the event that the Customer does not comply with the demand within twenty four hours of receipt, Cottenham shall be entitled without liability in trespass or otherwise to enter onto the Customer's premises at any time and to do all such things necessary in order to take possession of the Goods and remove the Goods from the premises.

In the event that the Customer cannot prove that specific goods relate to invoices for which Cottenham has already been paid, Cottenham shall be entitled to assume that all stock in the premises supplied by Cottenham relates to invoices that are unpaid by the Customer.

PAYMENT

Payment to Cottenham shall be made prior to dispatch of goods to Customer unless the Customer completes Cottenham's Application for credit, whereupon full payment for all invoiced items shall be made by the 14th day of the month which immediately follows the month in which the goods have been delivered to the Customer. Cheques and payments shall be made payable to Cottenham. Payments by cheque shall not be deemed made until the cheques have cleared.

PERSONAL PROPERTY SECURITIES ACT 2009 (PPSA)

If Chapter 4 of the PPSA would otherwise apply to the enforcement of a security interest in connection with these Terms and Conditions of Sale, the Customer agrees that the following provisions of the PPSA will not apply: section 95 (notice of removal of accession), to the extent that it requires the company to give notice to the Customer, section 96 (when a person with an interest in the whole may retain an accession) subsection 121(4) (enforcement of liquid assets - notice to grantor); section 125 (obligation to dispose of or retain collateral); section 130 (notice of disposal), to the extent that it requires the company to give a notice to the Customer; paragraph 132(3)(d) (contents of statement of account after disposal); subsection 132(4) (statement of account if no disposal); section 135 (notice of retention) and section 143 (reinstatement of security agreement). Notices or documents required or permitted to be given to the company for the purposes of the PPSA must be given in accordance with the PPSA. The Customer consents to the company affecting a registration on the PPSA register in relation to any security interest in connection with these Terms and Conditions of Sale and the Customer agrees to provide all assistance reasonably required to facilitate this. The Customer waives the right to receive notice of a verification statement in relation to any registration on the register. In these Terms and Conditions of Sale, the following words have the respective meanings given to them in the PPSA: account, proceeds, purchase money, register, registration, security interest and verification statement.

PRICES

Quoted in Australian dollars & are subject to change without notice.

RETURN OF STOCK

The Customer will ensure all orders are considered carefully as Cottenham cannot accept returned stock due to overordering. Any good stock to be returned must be approved by Customer Service in advance and must:

- be in unbroken cases in original carton
- be of current vintage as determined by Cottenham stock holdings
- not have been refrigerated at any time.
- not have been purchased as part of a bonus offer or all bonus stock must be returned in full.

WINE EQUALISATION TAX ("WET")

The Customer shall be liable to pay all WET on the goods unless, at the time the goods are ordered, the Customer validly requests exemption and accordingly quotes to Cottenham their Australian Business Number with their official order.
