Maximin Grünhaus Estate

The Maximin Grünhaus Estate located in the Ruwer Valley is famous for its high class wines. Beside Riesling (90%) the Estate cultivates also Pinot Blanc (6%) and Pinot Noir (4%). All vineyards of the Estate are hold by monopole and belong to the family Von Schubert who runs the Estate in the 5th and 6th Generation. The 34 hectares of vineyard are separated into three main parts. ABTSBERG, HERRENBERG and BRUDERBERG which differ mainly by their soiltype and steepness. All three of them are classified as VDP.GROSSE LAGE which means Grand Cru vineyard.

Tasting Notes

This Riesling has a charming lightness that which makes it hard to resist. Balanced and refreshing with fine crisp and Aromas of fresh apples, mirabelle and pear.

Perfectly fits to grilled dishes and German sausages.
