

Decal Grip Installation Instructions

Note: We can't express enough how important the use of a hair dryer or heat gun during installation is. Heat activates the adhesive and enables it to mold into the textures of the firearm. Even after removing the rubber-bands, continued heat and pressing down the edges may be required.

- 1. REMOVE MAGAZINE AND ALL AMMUNITION AND ENSURE THE FIREARM IS COMPLETELY UNLOADED BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH INSTALLATION!
- Make sure all outer surfaces of the unloaded firearm are clean and free of oil or grease.
- 3. Before peeling off the backing paper, hold the grip kit up to the firearm to see where the pieces go and how they will line up.
- 4. When removing decal grip pieces from the backing paper, be very careful not to tear, or allow the adhesive-side to stick to itself.
- 5. Start with the largest piece that will go onto the grip area of the gun. Peel it from the backing paper, line it up around the mag release and the bottom of the frame, then wrap the rest; aligning the with edges and contours of the firearm. If you need to adjust alignment of a piece, you should be able peel it back up and realign. Repeat this process for the rest of the grip kit.
- 6. IMPORTANT: When finished, Use a hair dryer to heat the grip, while pressing down all the edges. This will soften the adhesive and help it to mold into the texture of the gun's surface. In colder temperatures, longer and closer use of the hair dryer may be necessary.
- 7. Continue to press down the edges of the decal grip and press down into all the recessed contours of the gun until it cools to room temperature. Then wrap rubber-bands around the frame to hold all the edges down while the adhesive cures. ALLOW 24 HOURS FOR ADHESIVE TO FULLY CURE BEFORE REMOVING RUBBER-BANDS.

TIP: After wrapping the rubber-bands, wrap an ACE bandage around the gun for increased pressure, while the grip adhesive cures overnight.
