Stewards to be advised

- ❖ **Nomination forms and entry fees are to be received by 3pm Saturday 10th August 2019**, either in person or by scanning and then emailing to admin@mickymae.com.au. If you require a PayPal invoice, please indicate on your nomination form and one will be issued to you. This Invoice is payable within 24 hours of issue. Entry fees are \$5 per article.
- ❖ **Entry articles are to be delivered to Micky Mae at 43 Maryland Street, Stanthorpe, Qld by 3pm Tuesday 20 August**. If alternate arrangements for delivery need to be made, please contact us on admin@mickymae.com.au . **Articles will be available for pick up from Micky Mae from Monday 26 August**. Or if travelling and require them on the Sunday afternoon of the Quilt show, please indicate on your nomination form.
- ❖ Only one article per nomination form and multiple articles will require multiple nominations forms. NO EXCEPTIONS
- ❖ The stewards reserve the right to combine categories and also to move an article to a more suitable category if in the best interests of the entrant.
- ❖ A limit of 2 articles per person per category.
- ❖ Articles must have been finished in the past 3 years and if used, they must be clean, pressed and free of pet hair. All hanging articles (including table runners) must have a suitable rod pocket or tabs for hanging. If no rod pocket or tabs have been attached, your article will not be accepted and your entry fee forfeited.
- ❖ Work must be the entrants own work and commercial quilting must be acknowledged on the nomination form.
- ❖ If working from a commercial pattern, please indicate the pattern and designer on your nomination form. If you know the fabric collection there is space for you to list this as well.
- ❖ The novice section is for any first time entrant, who completed the entered article in the past 12 months.
- ❖ The junior section is for any entrant who completed the entered article, when under 18 years of age. Date of birth is required on your nomination form.
- ❖ Prizes are awarded at the judge's discretion. The judge's decision is final.
- ❖ Articles will be judged on precision of construction, creativity, colour, design, suitability of materials and useability.
- ❖ All care will be taken with articles, BUT the responsibility for insurance of your items rests with the entrant.
