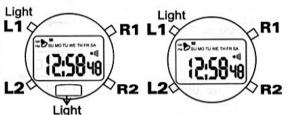

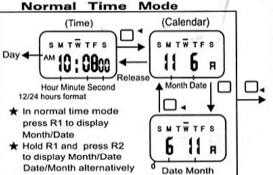

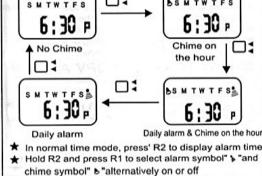


■ READING THE DISPLAY

Daily Alarm Mode **BSMTWTFS**



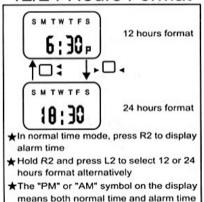
★ The alarm symbol " & " on the normal time display

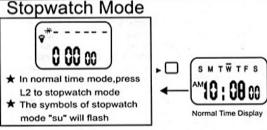

■ HOW TO SET ALARM TIME

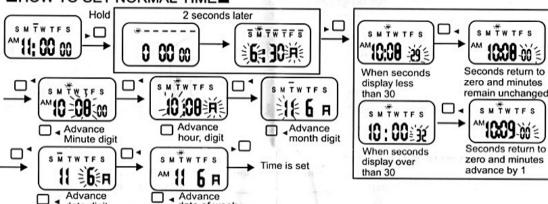
are in 12 hours format. Otherwise, they

- ★ In normal time mode, press and hold L2 first to stopwatch mode and hold 2 seconds to alarm time set mode, its symbol "MO" and hour digit begins flashing
- ★ press R1 to minute digit and advance with R2.
- * press L2 to normal time mode when alarm time is set

■HOW TO SET NORMAL TIME

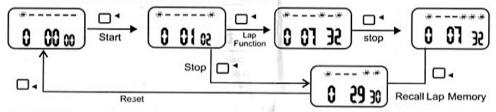


- ★ In normal time mode, hold L2 for 2 seconds to alarm time set mode, then press L2 again to normal time set mode its symbol "TU" and second digit begins flashing
- ★ Press R1 to change digits which will flash

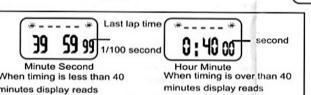

- ★ Then press R2 to advance flashing digit
- * Press L2 to normal time mode when time is set.

■HOW TO USE STOPWATCH

When timing is less than 40 minutes display reads Minute/Second/1/100 second Hour/Minute/Second

A.Net time measurement

- * In normal time, press L2 to stopwatch mode
- * press R1 to start, then press R1 again to sto
- * press R2 to return to zero

B. Lap time measurement:(For example many runners on a track)

Step 1:Press R1 to start then press R2 to display the first runner 's time

At this time inner timer still keeps on counting and lap symbol "TH" is flashing.

Step 2:Press R2 to release lap time display and start to display timing

Another pressure on R2 can display the second runner's time and inner timer still keeps on counting

Step 3:Repeat step 2 to display next runner 's time

Step 4:Now press R1 to stop timing and to display the last second runner's time

Step 5:Then press R2 to release lap time and to display the last runner's time

Step 6:Press R2 to return display to zero, press L2 to normal time mode

Remark: If there are only two runners skip step 2 & step 3.

TO PRESERVE THE QUALITY OF YOUR WATCH

- * As this watch contains precise electronic components, it is suggested that the backcover be removed only by authorized expert
- * Do not operate pushers when the watch is wet or in water
- * If the watch is used in water or if it is wet , wipe it thoroughly dry. If it is exposed to sea water once it in fresh water and then wipe it dry * Should water or condensation appear in the watch, immediately have it overhauled because water can conode electronic parts inside the case
- * Although the watch is designed to withstand shocks under normal use it is inadequate to subject it to rough impact
- * Clean the watch with a soft cloth or water never use chemical solution
- * Avoid exposing the watch to strong chemicals such as gasoline, aeros spray, paints etc. whose chemical action will damage watch
- * Avoid wearing the watch in electromagnetic condition
- * Renew battery at sales store when it is used up.
