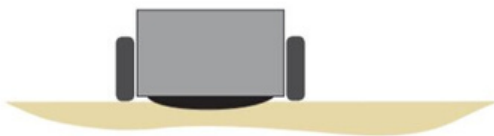
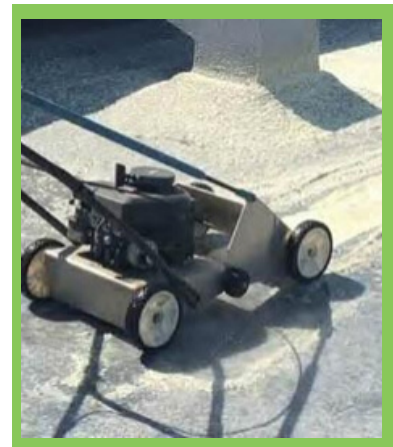
The Channel Master is an easily adjustable, lightweight tool for the aid of drainage on SPF roofs. In addition, your team will safely reduce the time and effort previously spent cutting the drainage channels by hand.

- Gas powered by Briggs & Stratton Engine
- Carbide tipped blade
- Maxium cut width is 10"

How Does the Channel Master Work on Spray Foam Roofing?

The Channel Master cuts perfectly shaped, tapered channels to aid in the drainage on SPF roofs. One of the major benefits of the Channel Master is that it leaves a super smooth surface – so there's no need for caulk – just cut and coat!

No matter the skill level of the SPF Technician, there is always an area that holds an undesirable amount of water after the roof is completed. Rather than doing what is required to increase the thickness of the roof in the area holding water, deploy the Channel Master. Starting at the area holding water, begin the Channel Master grinding process and move forward towards the drain, gutter scupper, etc. While adjusting the depth of the cut channel with the custom adjustment rod, increase the depth of the cut while the water flows immediately behind the channel. This removes the guesswork, ensuring the area holding water has positive slope. In addition, the employee operating the Channel Master has a lower risk for injury.
