

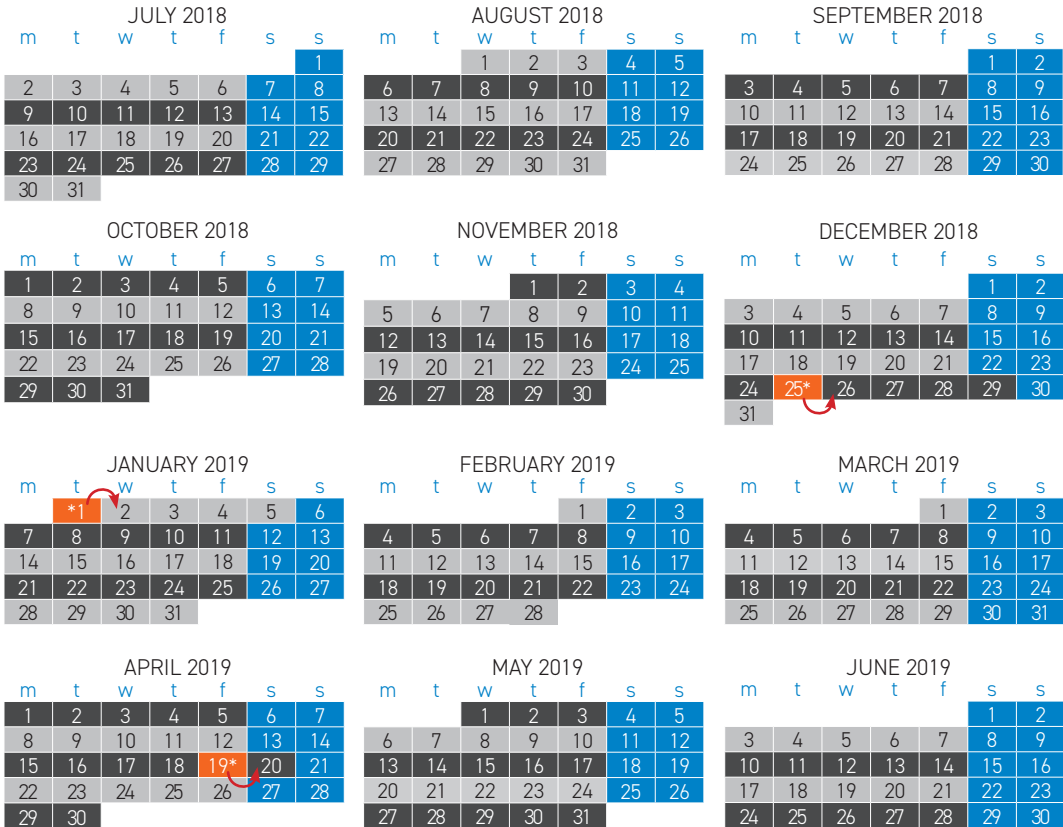


# RECYCLING CALENDAR

2018 - 2019

- Recycling (glass and other recycling) is collected every two weeks.
- Rubbish is collected every week.
- Your collection day is printed on your recycling bin.
- Place recycling at the kerbside by 7.00 am.

- Week 1 collections
- Week 2 collections
- Normal collection day change

 \* Good Friday collections occur on Saturday 20 April 2019.

## Changes to collection Days

Christmas Day and New Year's Day fall on Tuesday so rubbish and recycling will be picked up a day later from your normal recycling day for the rest of both weeks.

- E.g. If your normal collection day would have been Tuesday 25 December, put your rubbish and recycling out a day later, on the Wednesday.
- That pattern continues throughout each week, with Friday collections moving to Saturday.
- Collections return to normal from Monday 7 January 2019.



### What goes in your recycling bin?

- ✓ Clean plastic (No's 1-5 & 7)
- ✓ Clean tins/cans
- ✓ Clean paper/cardboard

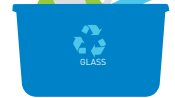


### What can't go in?

Glass, liquids, rubbish, meat trays, polystyrene, plastic bags, garden waste, food waste, disposable nappies, hot ashes, oven ware, electrical goods, engine oil bottles, automotive parts, paint and chemicals, bubble wrap ceramics, crockery, porcelain and tetrapaks.

### Use a blue crate for your glass

Only recycle empty, unbroken glass bottles and jars (clear, brown, blue and green). Most residents will already have a blue recycling crate that they can use for glass recycling. If you don't have one, contact Nelmac or the Council office.



### What goes in your rubbish?



If it can't be recycled, reused or composted it needs to go in the landfill.

## How do I find out what day my bin will be emptied?



- Each recycling bin is assigned to a specific street address. The collection day is written on the sticker – this is your day of the week for both your glass and mixed recycling collections.
- Your recycling will be collected every two weeks.
- The sticker shows if your collection is Week One or Two, then the day of the collection.
