Pedersen + Lennard furniture has been designed and crafted to last for generations. To ensure the longevity of your solid wood furniture, it is essential that it is cared for correctly.

Please take note of our care instructions and action accordingly, as failure to do so may void warranty. If unsure, please contact us and we'll gladly assist.

HOW TO OIL YOUR WOOD FURNITURE:

Pronature Wood Oil provided is ready to use, please do not dilute.

FOLLOW THESE QUICK EASY STEPS:

- 1. Sand timber
 - Lightly sand the wood with 220 grit sand paper until smooth to touch.
- (2.) Stir wood oil well

To ensure pigments are well incorporated in case of separation, stir wood oil thoroughly.

(3.) Apply wood oil

Apply an even generous coat of oil with a mutton cloth or clean white cloth. Avoid dripping or pooling on the surface.

- (4.) Wait for 10 minutes
 - (Or 5 minutes if hot or in the sun)

*Do not let the wood oil dry, wipe off while still wet.

(5.) Wipe off wood oil

With a clean, dry cloth (i.e. mutton cloth), wipe off the wood oil until all excess oil is gone.

(6.) Allow 6hrs to cure

HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR WOOD FURNITURE:

- When using the furniture for serving food and drinks, protective mats and coasters are recommended.
- Dust lightly with a clean, dry cloth.
- Wipe up spillages as soon as possible with a diluted solution of your Pronature Plant Soap Concentrate or a clean damp cloth.
- We do not recommend using any chemical and household cleaners as these can strip the wood of its naturals oils and moisture leaving it unprotected.

HOW OFTEN TO RE-OIL YOUR WOOD FURNITURE:

We recommend re-oiling your purchase:
1st Re-Oiling Two months after delivery.
2nd Re-Oiling Every 6 months or when wood looks dry, dull or rough.

Soaked, used cloths may spontaneously combust, and should be spread out or kept safely in a tightly sealed container or alternatively, submerged in water after use.

ProNature Wood Sealer:

A blend of plant oils to protect, impregnate and tint wood. ProNature Wood Sealer is food safe and can be used on cutting boards, toys, worktops, kitchen counters and more.

Ingredients:

Linseed oil, blend of vegetable oils, lead-free driers, natural and non-toxic mineral pigments. TVOC (total volatile organic content) 22.07 g/litre.

Pedersen + Lennard Finishes:

Natural Oil, Pure Oil, Coffee Oil + 5% White Oil.

Coverage:

Approximately 20-30m² per single application, depending on the type of wood.

Cleaning:

Use ProNature Plant Turpentine for brushes & rollers.

Use ProNature Plant Soap for all wooden surfaces.

Storage / Shelf Life:

Store in a cool, dry place. Minimum stability of 12 months in a closed container.

Disposal:

Oil based products must be taken to a hazardous landfill site or other municipal collection points.

DO NOT empty this oil based liquid residue into drains.

Safety:

Natural ingredients may cause allergies. Use only as directed. Keep out of reach of children.
