#### HOW TO OIL YOUR WOOD FURNITURE:

The Linseed Oil provided is ready to use, please do not dilute.

### FOLLOW THESE QUICK EASY STEPS:

- 1. Sand timber
  - Lightly sand the wood with 220 grit sand paper until smooth to touch.
- (2.) Apply Linseed Oil

Apply a single coat with a mutton cloth or clean white cloth. Avoid dripping or pooling on the surface.

(3.) Allow 6hrs to cure

## **HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR WOOD FURNITURE:**

- When using the furniture for serving food and drinks, protective mats and coasters are recommended.
- Dust lightly with a clean, dry cloth.
- Wipe up spillages as soon as possible with a diluted solution of your Pronature Plant Soap Concentrate or a clean damp cloth.
- We do not recommend using any chemical and household cleaners as these can strip the wood of its natural oils and moisture leaving it unprotected.

## HOW OFTEN TO RE-OIL YOUR WOOD FURNITURE: We recommend re-oiling your purchase: 1st Re-Oiling | Two months after delivery. 2nd Re-Oiling | Every 6 months or when the wood looks dull, dry or rough. IROKO WOOD: We use Iroko as our preferred outdoor choice of timber as it is naturally durable, and has rot and insect resistant properties. It is an African hardwood that is a yellow/medium brown and ages into a beautiful and timeless silver-grey patina. Kindly note: Fine hairline cracks may likely develop overtime. This is normal and is part of the natural aging process of the wood when exposed to the elements. **CAUTION:** Linseed oil is ignitable!
