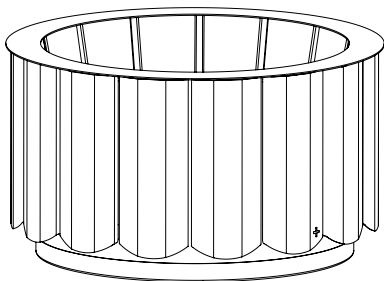

how to handle the heat

1. Playing with fire is for dragons and blacksmiths.
Allow the Fire Pit to cool completely before handling or emptying the ashtray.
2. Lift the grate to remove ash. Gently tip over and dust off excess debris.
3. Clean with warm soapy water and a soft cloth (a hosepipe is fine too).
4. Air dry or wipe dry with a clean cloth.
5. Polish the inside and top with stainless steel cleaner if desired. Work up a shine your mom would be proud of!

caution: fire is hot

- Intended for OUTDOOR USE ONLY.
- Always use the Fire Pit on a level surface. Fitted with adjustable feet, the fire pit can be easily stabilised and secured.
- The Fire Pit gets extremely hot when in use (as one would hope). Allow it to cool completely before touching or moving it in order to avoid injury both to your body and your pride.
- Do not leave the Fire Pit unattended. Think of it as your needy friend who came to the party alone and needs constant supervision.
- Earth, wind, and fire are a dangerous combo (especially musically). Keep an eye on the weather and don't light a fire in extremely windy conditions.
