| Control a lamp | Identify which lamp is being controlled in the app | Make sure lamp power source is on and working. If you have more than one lamp on the app, start with the first lamp icon and tap it once. If the VIVID lamp turns on/off, you have identified the lamp and can now control its color changing and dimming features. If the lamp did not turn on/off, move to the next lamp on the app and try again. Continue until you find the lamp you are trying to control. (See figure C below). | |
