The kettle is made from mouth blown borosilicate glass. The tea egg is made from pressed steel.

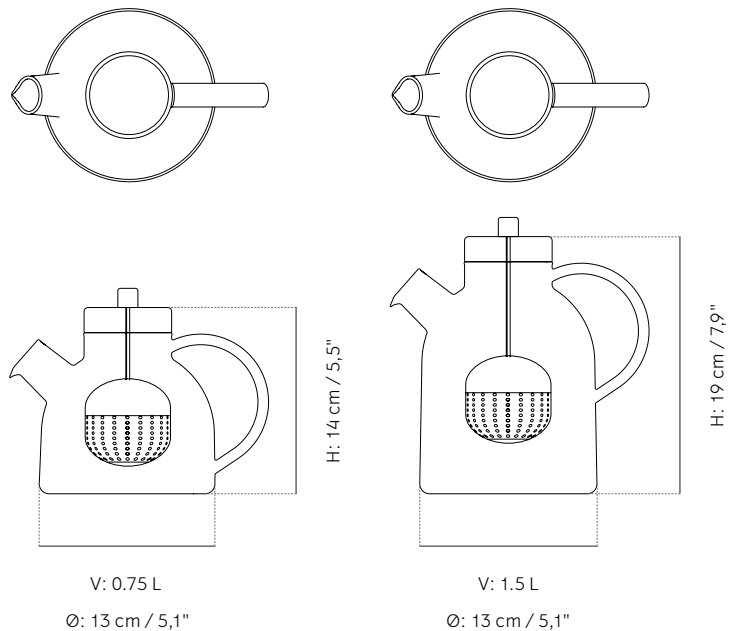

Care Instructions

For general use, the teapot, except for the lid, can be washed in a dishwasher on a normal washing program. We recommend using a cloth to dry afterwards. Do not use any cleaners with chemicals or harsh abrasives.



For those of us who drink tea, the daily pause to put on the kettle and linger awhile with our thoughts is precious. The Kettle Teapot is intended to slot into your tea drinking daily ritual. Its design is mindful of traditional Oriental cast iron teapots, re-interpreted here in heat-resistant glass. Kettle Teapot is a delight for all the senses – allowing the tea-brewer to feast on visual and aroma of tea. The ‘tea egg’ is placed in the centre of pot to hold the leaves. Raise the egg by its silicone string for a perfectly brewed cup every time. This new smaller size is made for one cup or two.
