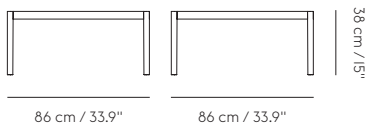
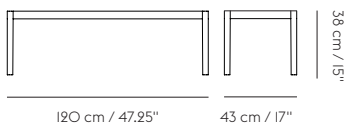




# WORKSHOP COFFEE TABLE

#### DESCRIPTION

The Workshop Coffee Table is deliberately simple in its design and has an almost archetypal expression, boiled down to the essence of Scandinavian craftsmanship. With its table top in oak veneer harmoniously carving itself into the frame of solid oak, the Workshop Coffee Table has a clean and understated expression.

#### PRODUCTION PROCESS

The Workshop Coffee Table is made using traditional techniques with an emphasis on craftsmanship and detailing. Frame and legs are made from solid wood alongside its tabletop in layer-glued oak veneer.

#### MATERIAL

Legs and frame in solid wood. Tabletop in oak veneer. Black version comes in water-based lacquered oak. Oak version comes with a matte clear water-based lacquer.

#### CLEANING AND CARE

Wipe off with moist cloth and remove excess liquid with dry cloth.
