WHITE WINES

J Mourat "Collection" White, 2018 – 14.99

Blend of Chardonnay and Chenin Blanc from 20 year old vines. Precise and elegant with notes of pear, peach, citrus & grapefruit. Bright acidity & minerality. Aged 3 months in Stainless Steel. Serve with appetizers, shellfish or oysters. Organic. Loire Valley, France

Tenuta Meraviglia Bolgheri Vermentino, 2017 – 15.99

Refreshing Vermentino with a touch of Viognier. Yellow fruity and floral aromas with nuances of sage, rosemary and herbs. Nicely bodied with a backbone of acidity and enduring finish. Meraviglia means "to marvel" in Italian, and these wines beg to be pondered. Hand harvested, fermented with indigenous yeasts in concrete vats; then aged on lees for a few months. Pair with fish and appetizers. Bolgheri DOC, Italy

RED WINES

Chateau du Trignon Cotes du Rhone, 2016 – 15.99

Deep, dark and ripe blend of Grenache, Mourvedre and Syrah from the Southern Rhône. It is full and brimming with dark blackberry, boysenberry and dark cherry fruits, a lush wine with baking spices and warmth. Soft tannins, long finish. Serve with Charcuterie, BBQ and heartier dishes. Cotes du Rhone, France

Schola Sarmenti Critèra Primitivo, 2017 – 15.99

100% Primitivo from the Salento region of Italy. Hand harvested and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Young and fresh, it is made from young vines; it is a dry, rich and vivacious wine. It is complex and fulfilling on the nose and palate with exotic spices underlying the fresh fruit.

Pinyolet Garnacha, 2016 – 15.99

100% Garnacha. A "pinyolet" is a pebble of limestone that results from the erosion of limestone boulders only found in the upper hills of Montsant. Montsant is cooler and higher in elevation than Priorat, and allows Garnacha to retain more acidity and make wines that are uplifted, floral, full of tension, and elegant. Vinified and aged in three year old French oak barrels. Rich strawberry and raspberry fruit intermixed with notes of licorice, crushed rock and earth.

McPherson MWC Cabernet Sauvignon, 2016 – 15.99

100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Medium bodied and delicious for warmer months; it displays notes of rich black fruits and berries complemented with elegant oak and a nuance of chocolate. Balanced with a firm, smooth tannin structure. Enduring length of ripe fruit and cedary oak. Winemaker notes to pair with a hearty barbequed steak, short ribs, or a mushroom pizza with spicy tomato sauce to heat things up a little! Goulburn Valley, Victoria, Australia

Buil & Giné Joan Gine Blanco, 2016 – 24.99

Dry white blend of mostly White Garnacha with Viognier, Macabeo and Pedro Ximenez. This wine is vinified like a red wine, fermented and aged in oak six months. It is a bold wine with fruity and floral aromas in combination with a broad and well-structured palate. Its complexity reveals its notable personality. With a mineral background, it is mature, silky in the mouth and meaty. Priorat, Spain

La Garnacha de Mustiguillo, 2015 — 24.99

100% Garnacha from Bodegas Mustiguillo whose principal focus is cultivating Bobal but there has always been Garnacha vines on the estate. Vinified in a single 8,000L French Oak Foudre with indigenous yeasts with some stem inclusion; malolactic fermention in smaller french oak barrels then aged 10 months in barriques. This is a ripe, full bodied and lush showing of Garnacha. Organic. El Terrerazo, Spain

Tenuta Meraviglia Bolgheri Rosso, 2016 – 28.99

Elegant blend of mostly Cabernet Franc with Cabernet Sauvignon. Intense ruby red hues, black fruit aromas, especially blackberries and cherries, with herbal nuances. Well-structured and refreshing with an enduring finish. Meraviglia means "to marvel" in Italian, and these wines beg to be pondered. Fermentation in concrete/wooden vats; soft pumping over. Aged one year French oak casks and three months in bottle. Pair with red meats or hearty dishes. Bolgheri DOC, Italy
