
WHITE WINES

Otto's Constant Dream Sauvignon Blanc, 2019 – 14.99

Lime zest, minerals, navel orange. Dry, crisp palate with some nice richness balancing out the brightness. Produced at Hunter's in Marlborough, one of the original wine estates established in 1979. Fermented predominately in Stainless Steel with small amount in French Oak to provide a layer of texture; resting on lees for 6 weeks. 100% Sauvignon Blanc.

"Le Fils des Gras Moutons", 2017 – 14.99

Honeycomb, peach, white flowers. Stone minerality on the palate. Dry and refreshing with a hint of peach pit and apricot. Made by Claude, Thérèse & Sébastien Branger in the Muscadet Sèvre et Maine region of France. The father and son team prunes their vines for low yields, harvests by hand (a rarity in this land of machine harvesting), and lets its wine rest on the lees until bottling, which is done without fining and with a light filtration—the classic sur lie technique. Sustainably farmed, organic. 100% Melon de Bourgogne.

RED WINES

Los Conejos Malditos, 2018 – 12.99

Bright plum, cinnamon stick, black cherry and red currant. Light and airy on the palate, counter-balanced with dry tannin, clove and stone. Made by Bodegas Mas Que Vinos, this wine showcases the semi-carbonic style. It's the light, bright styles consumed in Spain since wine consumption can be an everyday, lunch affair. Keeping it light and fun. 100% Cencibel (Tempranillo). Spontaneous whole cluster fermentation in small stainless steel tank. Organic.

Seghesio Barbera d'Alba, 2018 – 14.99

Boysenberry, cassis, graphite. Red raspberry compote, tobacco, purple flowers. Give it a little air before drinking -- decant, swirl or just open the bottle an hour or so early due to its recent release. The Seghesio family bought the estate in 1964 after the sharecropping system ended, selling the grapes. Brothers Riccardo and his late brother Aldo started Estate bottling the wines in the late 1980s. This is a long time favorite here! Italy in a bottle. Super food friendly. 100% Barbera. Stainless Steel fermentation. Practicing organic.

Three Wine Company Contra Costa County Zinfandel, 2018 – 15.99

Bramble berries, clove, tobacco, black currants, slight hint of menthol. Juicy, soft, giving, full bodied yet tidy and precise. The winery's motto is "The Dirt, the Micro-Climature and Don't Screw it Up". This is mostly Zinfandel, with also Petite Sirah, Carignane and Alicante Bouschet from vineyards planted around the bay area town of Oakley in Contra Costa County.

Redwood Red by Woodenhead, 2016 – 16.99

Cedar, blueberry jam, red cherry. Hint of anise, cinnamon apple bake, fleeting vanilla. Woodenhead is defined by its owner and winemaker, Nikolai Stez. Raised in the Russian River, his life has been defined by living and breathing winemaking. His style is pure with a bit of spunk. Unfined, unfiltered.

Seresin Sauvignon Blanc, 2018 – 22.99

Pomelo, grass, key lime. Soft, delicate texture. White grapefruit. This is a beautiful, elegant showing of Sauvignon Blanc that is silky while still presenting refreshing citrus notes. Michael Seresin pursued his passion for producing natural wine in the 90s in New Zealand; he is also known for his Cinematography work on films such as "Midnight Express" and "Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban". Wild yeast fermented, small portion in French oak. Organic, vegan.

Tchotiashvili Tavkveri "SB", 2017 – 26.99

Light bodied. Currant and bright spice. Cranberry, red berry and nutmeg. Lively and refreshing on the palate. Bright fruit, light, elegant and transmitting the unique method in which it is created. Using Qyevri, clay vessels buried in the ground, and ancient method of controlling temperature, the wine is fermented and gains its unique character. This wine is for contemplation. Only 1500 bottles produced. Each bottle hand numbered. 100% Tavkveri.
