MATIC WINES ŠIPON, 2021

Apricot, peach, pineapple with a pale, pearly, iridescent glow. Palate is nectarine pit + pineapple with a subtle spice undertone. Refreshing and light with an overall exotic vibe. 100% Šipon (also known as Furmint) is a native grape found mostly throughout northeastern Slovenia, Croatia, and Hungary. Matija Žerjav's (known to his friends as "Matic") Šipon comes from 50+ year old vineyards, which beautifully shows the true essence of the varietal with high acidity and zest. Matic chooses to farm organically and biodynamically not only to serve the wine well, but also so his kids can play in the vineyards.

DANCING CROW VINEYARDS SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2021

Citrus blossoms, orange fruit, grapefruit + lemon hit at once on a zesty nose. The palate is juicy with ripe oranges + volcanic minerality delivering freshness and sweet grapefruit. The grapes for the Dancing Crow Sauvignon Blanc sit at 1400 ft. elevation near the base of Mount Konocti on the western shore of Clear Lake in Northern California's Lake County. The soil is volcanic, with a microclimate that gets hot but also cools due to coastal breezes pulled in across the Mayacamas mountain range. This unique environment creates wine with depth of fruit but freshness and minerality. A truly unique and exciting Sauvignon Blanc.

CHATEAU CLEYRAC BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR, 2019

Dark blackberries, sweet cedar, spice + clove, intoxicating cocoa and menthol. Palate is light with a centered core of rich dark berries balanced by bright hues of citrus. 90% Merlot + 10% Cabernet Sauvignon grown outside the village of Villegouge, a small French village located in southwest France. Lydia Coudert, 5th generation of winemaker oversees the vineyard and winemaking. The Coudert family has been operating Château Cleyrac for 15+ years with Lydia becoming the first female winemaker for the estate after retiring from her first career in Engineering. She works with the vineyards to improve the health and converting to organic.

BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR | FRANCE

GARDACHO GARNACHA, 2020

Dusty, earthy strawberry with notes of menthol, tobacco, vanilla bean, eucalyptus. Palate is rich raspberry, wild strawberry, crème, coffee bean, mint leaf with streaks of spunkiness. José Manuel and his wife Maria Saenz-Olazabal's vineyards are never irrigated, never see herbicides or chemicals. They focus on purity and concentration, with a minimalist hand in the cellar. This Garnacha comes from 75+ year old vines, fermented in concrete vats and stainless steel to retain the bright character of the fruit. It then spends 8 months in old giant French oak vats to develop nuance before bottling.

DOMAINE LAFOUGE BOURGOGNE ALIGOTE, 2020

White, chalky minerality, white flowers, hints of sweet macademia, yellow flowers. Palate is creamy with creme brulee notes, lime kaffir, mandarin torte; Dreamy yet bright and crisp. 100% Aligoté from 60+ year old vines, half barrel-fermented and half fermented in stainless steel. Aligoté has a long history in the Burgundy region of France, yet mostly forgotten in the shadows of Chardonnay. Here is where you can enjoy the unique soils of Burgundy but on a vessel that is unique from Chardonnay, it is textured yet also supremely racy and regal.

COS FRAPPATO, 2021

Vibrant black cherry, cinnamon, nutmeg, fresh English garden herbs, hint of sweet black licorice, rustic mulberry with undertones of oceanic minerality. Palate is swift with red cherry, tapenade, raspberry, pine + brush notes. COS was founded in 1980 by three friends, Giambattista Cilia, Giusto Occhipinti, and Cirino Strano [all legends in winemaking], yet the winery itself dates to the 1880s. Sicily has a winemaking history dating to 8th Century BCE when Greeks first planted grapes there. 100% Frappato grown organically with biodynamic principles. Fermented and aged in concrete with indigenous yeast.

VAN DUZER WILLAMETTE VALLEY PINOT NOIR, 2020

Wild strawberry, hints of citrusy lemon + orange, pine, twigs, chocolate, whiffs of vanilla. Palate is bright with a yin-yang white + milk chocolate vibe, orange blossoms, dark cherry, strawberry pie and smoky undertones. Carl and Marilyn Thoma created their family estate in 1998 at the foothills of the Van Duzer Corridor, intrigued by the microclimate that is blessed by marine breezes from the Pacific Ocean drawing into the Willamette Valley. Van Duzer Vineyard's adopted goddess of wind, Zephyra, was brought to life by famed illustrator John Martinez, reflecting their appreciation of the gentle west wind in Greek mythology.
