LES JAMELLES VIOGNIER, 2021

Shy pear, perfumed acacia, saline. Palate is fresh and light with tangy apricot on a sturdy, round citrus fruit driven palate. 100% Viognier, fermented in Stainless Steel, aged on less 6-9 months. Founders Catherine and Laurent met as oenology students in 1986, coming from Beaujolais and Burgundian wine families. After travelling, they discovered their passion to create varietal specific wine, focusing on the Languedoc region due to the diversity of the terroir and affordability of land. Founded in 1995, "Les Jamelles" evokes the thread of roundness of throughout their wines, using the plural form to highlight the focus on multiple varietals.

GASPARD SAUVIGNON BLANC, 2022

Sweet peaches, fresh melon. Soft and fruity, with fluffy creme and summer peaches on a refreshing and well defined, mineral-touched palate. Gaspard is a house label of legendary natural wine importer, Jenny & François. All of their wines are made with traditional low-intervention methods, from sustainable and organic vineyards, fermented with native yeasts to express the essence of the land. "Gaspard" is a traditional French boy's name that means "bringer of treasure" – a perfect description for the friendly, naturally made Sauvignon Blanc brought to us by Jenny Lefcourt.

SCARPETTA CABERNET FRANC, 2021

Berries, tobacco, whiffs of vanilla, blackberries, raspberries, hints of cedar on an uber dry, food-friendly palate. 100% Cabernet Franc, which has been grown in the Friuli Venezia Giulia region for hundreds of years. Stainless Steel fermentation and aging, providing freshness and spunkiness to the wine. The Scarpetta brand is inspired by the Friuli region of Italy & created as an homage to the everyday Italian lifestyle of "drinking good wine, great conversation, and little moments of celebration" by Master Sommelier Bobby Stuckey and former French Laundry Chef Lachlan Patterson.

ANNABELLA ALEXANDER VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2020

Delightfully elegant with notes of berries, cocoa, espresso, and spice layered in an impressive palate. Mary Ann Pozzan and Michael started their winery and ran every aspect of the business until their sons Dante and later Matthew joined them in the business. A true family run winery, with Michael Pozzan as head winemaker, has a uniquely consistent thread of love and passion throughout their wines. Alexander Valley lies in the northeastern corner of Sonoma, an ideal spot for growing Cabernet Sauvignon. 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

OLIVIER MORIN "CONSTANCE" BOURGOGNE CHITRY, 2022

Minerally salted lemon with delicate white flowers. Mineral driven, chalky, Chablis-esque. Native yeast fermentation, aged on lees in Stainless Steel tank. Olivier Morin's "Constance" Chitry is lighter, fresher and released in its youth. 100% Chardonnay. Chitry is nestled in a small valley just at the edge of Chablis - historically cherries were planted in Chitry and grapes in Chablis. However the Morin family with roots in the village of Chitry le Fort for generations with this estate in the family since at least 1650 had always planted grapes. Olivier joined his brother at the Domaine and began estate bottling their wine in 1992.

YVES CUILLERON CROZES-HERMITAGE "LABAYA", 2020

Full, soft and voluptuous, with a dark berry juicy core laced with rustic Rhone, dried herb and savory vibes, this is a beautiful and pure expression of 100% Syrah from the Crozes-Hermitage appellation of the North Rhone Valley. The Cuilleron estate was first founded in 1920, Yves' grandfather first started bottling wine in 1947. Yves took over in 1987 from his uncle, expanding vineyards and building a new winery, becoming one of the most significant estates in the area of Condrieu. All vineyard work is done by hand, fermentation with indigenous yeasts in open top vats, aged in barrel 16 months.

MIRO COYOTE RIDGE VINEYARD PETITE SIRAH, 2021

Luxuriously silky blue and blackberries with rounded, subtle hints of vanilla, cinnamon and toast. "Born and raised in northern Bulgaria, Miro (Miroslav) Tcholakov was exposed to winemaking at a very early age. His grandfather had long made the family supply of wine. As a boy, Miro was at his side during all phases of the process." In 1998 Miro went to work for Trentadue Winery, where he is still head winemaker. This Miro project is all his own which he does in small production on the side. The grapes for this wine come from a tiny 1.2 acre 27+ year old dry-farmed vineyard, Coyote Ridge, which situated in the middle of Dry Creek Valley.
