SAN BENEDETTO VERNACCIA DI SAN GIMIGNANO, 2019

Pear & summer lemonade on a dry, crisp palate of lemony citrus, green apple, saline & frosted minerals with a firm personality. The DOCG of Vernaccia di San Gimignano is in the Siena province of Tuscany, where Chianti Colli Senesi is made. Vernaccia di San Gimignano is interestingly considered to not be related any other Vernaccia and has been cultivated in the area since likely 1276, and (much!) later awarded DOCG status in 1993. The Gianelli family have cultivated vineyards, olive groves and livestock in San Benedetto since 1826; in the 1960s the family first started buying land. Run by the same family today, Giovanni, Andrea and Marco.

"LOST" FOR EKLETIKON, 2022

Apricot, cumquat, orange blossoms. Light + bright palate, laced with white flowers, orange, lime. "A fun, low intervention wine" made by small family wineries in Peloponnese for Greek wine importer, Eklektikon. Native Greek varietals, 80% Moschofilero + 20% Malagousia. Wild yeast, temperature controlled fermentation and aging in stainless steel tank. The southern Peloponnese peninsula is heavily influenced by the Mediterranean, and has the greatest numbers of Greek wine appellations on its dramatic landscape.

PAXTON CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2021

Dark inky in color with deep boysenberries, cinnamon, ground coffee, tree bark, wilderness on the nose. Palate is focused and concentrated with fresh blackberries and espresso notes. Wonderfully clean with a mineral backbone. From Paxton's family-owned organic, biodynamic vineyards in the McLaren Valle of Southern Australia. Established in 1979 by David Paxton, one of Australia's most highly respected viticulturalists (vineyard management), the family has nurtured their vineyards in the area for three decades. Winemaking is led by Ashleigh Seymour with Kate Goodman.

MOLINO LANGHE NEBBIOLO "VITALIS", 2020

Baked red cherry, spiced cranberry, vanilla puffed cream, caramel. Firm tannins smoothed with a black Luxardo cherry core and hints of black tea. Azienda Agricola Molino was started by brothers' Tommaso (marketing), Franco (vineyard manager) and Dario (oenologist) Molino's father Virginio Molino in 1991. Today they run the winery with the same passion as their father along with his grandson, Marco Molino. 100% Nebbiolo from the family's vineyards in Treiso. Fermented in Stainless Steel, aged in barrique and 10hl oak barrels. Classic, beautifully simple yet lovely and expressive Langhe Nebbiolo.

SANS LIEGE "COTES-DU-COAST", 2022

Tangerine, white flowers, ocean air, lemon verbena. Palate has a smooth vanilla cream core, encased with orange blossoms, graham cracker and white pepper. White Rhone Blend of Viognier, Marsanne, Roussanne, Grenache Blanc and Clairette. Curt Schalchlin makes both Sans Liege and Groundwork wines, his passion sourced from the freedoms of the New World in winemaking and the heritage of the Rhone Valley. From selected vineyards along the coast - ranging from Santa Maria Valley in Santa Barbara to Templeton Gap in Paso Robles. Aged 7 months on the lees in French Oak; 10% new oak, the balance second-fill and neutral oak.

KARL HAIDLE LEMBERGER BUNTER MERGEL, 2021

Bright red cherry, red licorice, hickory, sweet anise. Palate is old world, beautifully classic with hints of green tea, raspberry. Lemberger is the German name for the grape varietal Blaufränkisch, most widely grown in Austria. Bunter Mergel translates to "colored marl", referring to the distinctive terroir of the Häder vineyard. Weingut Karl Haidle is the oldest private winery in the Remstal, led by his grandson, Moritz Haidle. A true artist at heart, a freestyle rapper and graffiti artist, is tireless in balancing tradition and intuition in winemaking. Fermented with native yeasts, aged in neutral barrique. Demeter biodynamic certified.

SANS LIEGE "THE OFFERING", 2020

Brush, cassis, violets, eucalyptus, hints of anise. Palate is deep and generous, rounded with redwood, dark and ripe berries, touched with vanilla. Red Rhone Blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. Curt Schalchlin makes both Sans Liege and Groundwork wines, his passion sourced from the freedoms of the New World in winemaking and the heritage of the Rhone Valley. From selected vineyards along the coast - ranging from Santa Maria Valley in Santa Barbara to Templeton Gap in Paso Robles. Aged 21 months in French Oak; 29% new oak, the balance second-fill and neutral oak.
