WHITE WINES.

DRY CREEK VINEYARD CHENIN BLANC, 2022

16.99

Pineapple, papaya, gala apple, salted lemon, lime. Palate smooth and textured with salted caramel, citrus. 100% Chenin Blanc, fermented in Stainless Steel with no oak aging gives this wine its immense freshness factor while the Chenin Blanc provides its texture. The family has been producing this wine for 51 vintages, since 1972. Sourcing from Clarksburg provides the fabric to create their Loire Valley inspired Chenin Blanc. Dry Creek Vineyards continues to be family owned, founded 52 years ago when Dave Stare bought his first parcel of land in the Dry Creek Valley area of Sonoma County, planting the region's first vines since Prohibition. DOMAINE DE LA POINTE "LES PIEDS DANS LE SABLE" LES LANDES, 2022 17.99

Tropical notes, yellow + white peach, nectarine, cinnamon, yellow sweet flowers. Palate is fresh juicy peach + peach cobbler, framed by minerals and a nectar structure. "Les Pieds dans le sable" literally means "toes in the sand", referring to the sandy soils of Landes, the region in which the vineyards for this wine is grown. The Capbreton commune is on the Southwestern coast of France, just north of Biarritz 800 meters from the Atlantic Ocean - the wine is heavily influenced by this maritime climate. A fresh, friendly blend of Gros Manseng, Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin Blanc.

FINCA DE LOS PADRILLOS MALBEC, 2021

Intoxicating dark blackberry, suede + leather, caramel, black cherry. Palate is salted dark chocolate and caramel, concentrated blackberry core finish, dusted with cocoa. "Founded by Ernesto Catena, a fourth-generation winemaker of Italian descent, Padrillos wines are inspired by Ernesto's passion for horses." Padrillos, or stallions, "expresses the wild spirit of Argentina's true varietals." 100% Malbec. The Catena family is one of, if not the most well-known Argentinian winemaking families.

SEGHESIO DOLCETTO D'ALBA, 2021

Bright brambly berry, plum, peony. Palate floods with red roses, raspberry, strawberry. The Seghesio Estate has been in the family since 1964, when the practice of sharecropping ended and the family bought the vineyards. Brothers Riccardo and his late brother Aldo started bottling the wine under the family name in the late 1980s. Seghesio creates classic, solidly Italian wines... pristine in style, a focused showcase of the Langhe terroir. 100% Dolcetto which is the varietal the local Piedmontese Italians drink for everyday living. Brighter in character, food friendly, meant to be enjoyed in its youth, it's like your new best friend.

CASCINA FÈIPU DEI MASSARETTI PIGATO, 2021

Salt, fresh lemon, white grapefruit. Palate is gentle with linen, pomelo, honeycomb, saline. Agostino "Pippo" Parodi and his wife Bice inherited this special estate from Pippo's grandfather which at the time was mostly growing fruits & vegetables. They converted over the land starting in the 1960s to planting vineyards of native Ligurian varietals, mostly Pigato and also Rossesse. The estate is named Feipu (local dialect for grandfather) and Massaretti, the locality. Now led by their daughter Brunella and her husband, Mirco Mastroianni. Small family estate, doing incredible work to keep these native varietals compelling and interesting.

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GROUNDWORK WINE CO. CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2021

Spicy, almost cayenne pepper on the nose that drifts into lilac and violet, fresh laundry, Big Red gum, delicate white tiny flowers, tea. Palate is dry and polished with mulberry, generous dark berries, edged with faint hints of creme brulee, chocolate, red pepper. Old World winemaking in the New World; Fermented in Stainless Steel with native yeasts, aged in neutral French oak, bottled unfined and unfiltered. Curt Schalchlin makes both Sans Liege and Groundwork wines, his passion sourced from the freedoms of the New World in winemaking and the heritage of the Rhone Valley.

Bristle, bougainvillea, grape bubblegum, white pepper, bark, hickory, fresh cut wood. Palate is elusive and seductive at the same moment, timid yet brimming with cherries. John Seccombe seeks out vineyards across the Western Cape that inspire him to create transparent wine reflecting the vineyards' unique characteristics. The "Wanderer's Heart" falls under the umbrella of naming their wines evoking childhood themes, while also describing the quest to find these vineyards.
