LA BASTIDE SAINT DOMINIQUE CÔTES DU RHÔNE BLANC, 2022

15.99

Juicy lemon, mandarin orange, breezes of lime, salinity notes. Palate is dewy and soft with fresh orange, white peach, wildflower. Blend of Viognier, Grenache Blanc, Clairette from the Southern Rhône Valley. La Bastide Saint Dominque was built around a former 16th century chapel, in the heart of Provence, at the footfills of Châteauneuf du Pape. The estate is sun-kissed and influenced by the strong Mistral winds that flow through this region. Founded by Marie-Claude and Gérard Bonnet over 40 years ago, led by their son Eric since 1999, they are committed to the environment with organic certification.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE | FRANCE

TENUTA DI TAVIGNANO PASSERINA, 2022

Lime blossom, orange curd, sugared lemon. Orange slice candy, frosted flakes on a high energy, spirited, dry, crisp palate. Passerina is the lesser known native white varietal from central Italy, grown on the Adriatic Coast in the Marche region where Verdicchio and Pecorino are the predominate varietals. The microclimate of Tenuta di Tavignano is ideal, with higher altitude, diurnal temperatures (warm days, cool nights) and soft slopes resulting in brilliant wines. While the Estate is family held, there is a deep team of exceptional people that invest in the land through organic farming as well as balancing tradition and innovation.

RED WINES -

YVES CUILLERON SYRAH "LES VIGNES D' A COTE", 2021

Young and charming with blackberry, spiced dark berry preserves, hints of hickory, streaks of mulberry. Palate is mineral and berry driven, breezy yet definitely Syrah with its dark and seductive vibes. Charming, delicate and fresh. Third generation family owned Estate founded in 1920, now led by Yves, Cuilleron is one of the benchmark producers of the Rhône. This bottling is an "IGP" or Vin de Pays designated as Collines Rhodaniennes. 100% Syrah from the Northern Rhône Valley which is markedly wetter and cooler than the Southern Rhône.

MCNAB RIDGE MENDOCINO MERLOT, 2020

Dark berries, baking spices, toasty oak. Medium bodied with black cherry, plum, cocoa undertones. This bottling is 86% Merlot, bolstered with 14% Cabernet Sauvignon from Damiano, Open Hand, White Oak and Largo Vineyards in Mendocino County. Aged 22 months in French and American oak. The McNab Ridge winery sits in the back of the McNab Valley, originally settled by Scottish sheep rancher and immigrant, Alexander McNab. Winemaker Rich Parducci is a fourth-generation winemaker of the Parducci family which has a rich history in the area, making wine here for over 70 years.

DIVISION VILLAGES L'ISLE VERTE CHENIN BLANC, 2022

Tart tangerine, salt, lemon. Soft with lemonade, white grapefruit, juicy orange vibes. Smooth, stony with hints of vanilla cream on the palate. Division Wine Company, founded by Kate Norris and Thomas Monroe in 2010, is based in Portland, Oregon, with grapes coming from what they describe as terroir expressive vineyards across Oregon and Washington. The energy of Division is young, with a refreshing outlook on winemaking in the New World, striving toward completely hands-off to let the vintage express itself while keeping care to not let the wine run wild in this natural approach. 100% Chenin Blanc from old vines in the Yakima Valley. CRUNCHY ROASTIE BY STOLPMAN VINEYARDS, 2022

Cola, purple berries. Sweet violets, boysenberry rounded with cream. Bright and friendly. Palate is juicy upfront then settles into a crunchy, feisty glass. Herb and balsamic notes. All the spunk of Syrah but delivered with a gentle touch. "Crunchy Roastie" is Stolpman's ode to Northern Rhône Syrah, developed by the family over time by altering their winemaking techniques to pull back on cellar interventions and leveraging a lightweight approach, picking the Syrah earlier and using Carbonic fermentation. In addition, to pull more aromatics and bright fruit, 5% of Viognier is co-fermented to give the Syrah a softening edge.

BALLARD CANYON AVA | SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

PODERI SANGUINETO I E II "SANGUINETO" ROSSO TOSCANO, 2021

Floods of wildflower, sweet lilac and cedar, saddle and suede, peony, herbal notes. Palate is playful with loads of verve, cherry and Tuscan countryside. Poderi Sanguineto I e II is a special estate focused on Nobile di Montepulciano led by Dora Forsoni, the youngest of founder Federico Forsoni's 9 children, who lovingly still works the vines by hand. Farming is organic, winemaking is spontaneous with native yeasts in concrete tanks and then aged in French and Slovenian oak. 100% Prugnolo Gentile, the local clone of Sangiovese, this bottling is a new addition to Sanguineto's wines.
