KAT

BARISTA

Name?

BARISTA

Kat! What a ferocious name. Got it! \$6.75.

KAT pays.

BARISTA

It'll be right up!

KAT goes and finds a seat. Takes a few books out of her backpack. LEAH enters, carrying just a small wallet.

BARISTA

(Facing away making KATS coffee)
