SMALL GROUP SESSION 1 INTRO

Have you ever faced a problem that you just couldn't figure out?



Who's Who? Let's see if you know who these famous people are based only on what they do or have done.





- What does it mean that all things were created through Him?
- Why do you think it's important that Jesus, God Himself, became flesh and dwelt among us?
