

# GIVE ONE

## Knit Flat



<b>SIZE</b> Baby (Child, Small Adult, Large Adult)	<b>GAUGE &amp; TENSION</b> 22 stitches over 10cm using 4mm needles	<b>ABBREVIATIONS</b> K knit P purl K2tog knit 2 sts together P2tog purl 2sts together st(s) stitch(es) rep repeat pm place marker
<b>FINISHED MEASUREMENTS</b> Baby W 18cm, H 14cm Child W 20cm, H 15cm Small Adult W 23cm, H 20cm Large Adult W 25cm, H 22cm	<b>YARN</b> 2x50g 8ply yarn	
	<b>NEEDLES &amp; NOTIONS</b> 4mm needles, or size to obtain gauge 9 stitch markers	

## INSTRUCTIONS

With 4mm needles cast on 80 (90, 100, 110)sts. (The rib may be worked using 3.75mm needles if you have them. Remember to change to 4mm when starting the body of the beanie).

Work [K1,P1] ribbing for 3 (4, 5, 5)cm (or 6-9cm for a folding brim)

### Start Body

Work in stocking st (knit one row, purl one row).

Work until hat measures 12 (13, 14, 15)cm from the cast on edge.

For beanie with a folding brim, fold the brim in half then measure.

Finish with a purl row.

### Shape Crown :

Divide into 10 sections as follows:

**Row 1:** [K6 (7, 8, 9), K2tog, pm] rep to end of row (no need to pm on last st). (10 sts decreased)

**Row 2:** P all sts

**Row 3:** [K to 2 sts before marker, K2tog] x9, K to last 2 sts, K2tog. (10 sts decreased)

**Rep row 2 and 3** until 30 sts remain.

**Next row:** P1, P2tog (20sts)

**Last row:** K2tog (10sts)

Cut yarn, thread through remaining sts and tighten off. Sew seam and weave in ends.

This pattern is for the purpose of charity knitting and giving only. Neither the pattern nor hats knitted from it are to be resold for profit.
