FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

W 24cm, H 22cm

YARN

1x50g 8ply yarn

GAUGE

Loose: 5 triangles and 12sc to 10cm with a 4.5mm hook

Tight: 5.5 triangles and 16sc to 10cm with a 6.5mm hook

NEEDLES & NOTIONS

hook to obtain gauge
yarn needle

ABBREVIATIONS

(American crochet terms used)

ch chain

sc single crochet

dc double crochet

BLO back loop only

sl st stitch

sl st slip stitch

hdc half double crochet

SPECIAL STITCHES

Triangle: [dc, ch1, dc] all into the same stitch or space.

INSTRUCTIONS

If you crochet loosely start with 8sc, if you crochet tightly start with 9sc and follow numbers in (brackets)

To find out if you are have a loose or tight crochet style, using a 4.5mm hook, crochet a chain 48cm long. Count the number of sts. If you have around 60 sts use the 4.5mm hook. If you have a much larger number of sts, e.g 80-90, use a 6.5mm hook and start with 9sc. Another option is to use an 8mm hook and work with 8sc.

Rnd 1: Start with a magic circle, make 8 (9)sc into the centre then pull the circle tight. Join with a sl st. [8(9)sc]

Rnd 2: Ch3 to start and dc BLO in the same space (counts as 1 triangle), triangle [dc, ch1, dc] in BLO of each stitch around, join with a sl st into the second ch. [8 (9) triangles]

Rnd 3: Sl st into first triangle space (this is the space created by the ch of the triangle below), ch3 and dc in the same space (counts as 1 triangle), work triangles into the space (not the stitch) between each dc, join with a sl st into the second ch. [16 (18) triangles]

Rnd 4: Sl st into first triangle space, ch3 and dc in the same space (counts as 1 triangle), dc between the triangles, [triangle into the next triangle space, dc into the space between triangles] rep around, join with a sl st into the second ch. [16(18) triangles and 16 (18) dc]

Rnd 5: Ch1, work in BLO, sc around, join with a sl st. [64 (72)sc]

Rnd 6: Ch3 and dc in the same space (counts as 1 triangle), [skip 2sc, triangle in next sc] rep around, join with a sl st into the second ch. [21(24) triangles]

Rnd 7-8: Sl st into first triangle space, ch3 and dc in the same space (counts as 1 triangle), triangle in each triangle space around, join with a sl st into the second ch. [21(24) triangles]

Rnd 9: Ch1, work in BLO, sc around, join with a sl st. [63(72)sc]

Rep rnd 6-9 two more times

Rnd 18: Ch2, work in BLO, hdc around, join with a sl st. [63(72)hdc]

Rnd 19: Ch1, work in BLO, sc around, join with a sl st. [63(72)sc]

Measure the hat. Repeat rnd 18+19 once more if necessary to measure 22cm.

(Another option to make the hat longer is to work 2 rnds of sc BLO (rnd 5 and 9) between the triangle sections)

Cut yarn and fasten off. Weave in ends.

Sew a large MGL tag to the brim of the beanie, 1 cm up from the egde..
