










*NOTE:

The appropriate torque for a 1/4 - 20 grade two bolt is between 37 - 43 in-lbs. Which is approximately 3 ft- lbs. The heads will shear off between 15-20 ft-lbs. Use caution when using power tools.




Clear anodized cross bar for mounting wind deflector

Installation:



Assemble the rack as shown above. The **drop in points on the black crossbars install facing up. We suggest hand tightening all hardware first. Then tighten all hardware once the rack is fully assembled. Once the rack is complete place the rack on the UTV and locate the mounting holes on the mounting points on your UTV. If you have a plastic roof installed it will be necessary to drill the roof to accept the mounting bolt. These holes can be sealed with silicone if the roof needs to be water tight.

Installation:




Once the rack if fully assembled, place the rack on the roof of the UTV. Line the rack up with the corresponding mounting rear holes in the roll cage. With the mounting holes located, mark and drill the roof panel for the mounting hardware to pass through. The Hole should be 3/4" to allow the spacer to pass through the roof an attach to the roll cage.

Locating:



Place a ruler on the bottom edge of the highest roof angle as shown (Pic A). This will locate the front mounting hole. Start by drilling a pilot hole to verify and center the location. Drill the hole to 3/4" to allow the spacers to pass through the roof Pic (B,C,D)



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
