


## Assembly Instructions Cone Stands by Tony Barber (TB103CSJ)





Assembled Cone


When using cone as stands for heavy items try the following tips:

- 1. Stack the small cone on top of the assembled large cone.
- 2. Cut cone and base from heavy cardstock.
- 3. Place a small weight of some sort into the cone before adhering the circle base into the cone.



## Step 1

Cut a cone and a base circle from die and bend in the two triangular ends of flap on the cone



Step 3 Place adhesive or tape onto the four tabs around the circular base. Bend those tabs along the crease.





Step 2

Wrap the cone around and insert the tab into the slit. Bend triangular ends out inside the cone and adhere using tape or adhesive.

## Step 4

Turn cone upside down and place circle base into the bottom. The tabs should just come to the edge of the cone base and the circle base will fit snug into the cone base.
