Listed below are recommended skills your child should master before completing each level. Use these pre-requisites to help you decide which level would best fit your child.

*****If your child is unable to complete the skills needed for Level 2, Level 1 imbeds introductory academic concepts into the social skills curriculum.***

<p>This Level is designed for ALL ages, imbedding introductory academic concepts within social skill building activities for the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Understanding Diversity * Understanding Safety Rules * Taking Turns with Loved Ones * Taking Care of My Things * Emotions and Feelings * Teaching Indoor vs. Outdoor Expectations * Supporting Age Appropriate Behavior * Preparing for Successful Outings * Preparing for Travel with Children * Creating Successful Transitions * Trying New Foods * Surviving Meals in Restaurants <p>This Social/Emotional Skill building Level is designed for ALL ages.</p>	<p>A child should start at this level if they can do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Complete patterns using two elements * Name familiar shapes * Count 5 objects * Recognize the names of numerals * Name body parts and their function * Classify objects by at least two properties (i.e. Size, color) * Identify colors * Follow unfamiliar directions * Use words and gestures to communicate * Engage in Adult-Led activities * Use language in complex conversations. <p>Please start at Level 1 if your child needs support in any of the above learning objectives.</p>	<p>A child should start at this level if they can do the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Understand measurement vocabulary (big, small, long, short) * Recite numbers 1 through 10 in order * Describe similarities and differences of several shapes * Create two step patterns * Understands that letters make words * Uses language to talk about past events * Uses words and increasing vocabulary to retell a story * Write all uppercase Letters of the Alphabet. * Recognize sounds of all letters of the alphabet * Follow simple two-step directions * Use child-sized scissors <p>Please start at Level 2 if your child needs support in any of the above learning objectives.</p>
