DABPRESS* D.I.Y HYDRAULIC PNEUMATIC PRESSES QUICK START GUIDE

Models: bj3t33, bj3t33 Pro, bj6t35



- 1. Move hydraulic rosin press to working area. Tip: Be sure to protect your working area from scratches during operation.
- 2. Plug in power to the Rosin Control Box, turn on both platen power switches, and main power.
- 3. Set desired temperature on Rosin Control Box. Recommend 160-200F for fine material, 180-220F for flower
- 4. Close the release valve on bottle jack using the notched end of the jack handle. Turn it clockwise until it's closed.
- 5. Insert jack handle into socket
- 6. Prepare your puck
- 7. Insert Parchment paper in between open plates, then insert your puck.
- 8. Pump the jack handle down and up slowly (finer material must apply pressure at a much slower speed!). Continue to slowly apply pressure until either the color darkens considerably or you feel it is already very tight.
- 9. Start a timer for 90 seconds. Check for additional flow during this time, and determine when to end your pressing time.
- 10. Remove the jack handle from the socket and open the release valve by turning it counter clockwise ½ turn.
- 11. Remove parchment paper and puck carefully from the open platens.





- 12. Collect your material, a cold plate from the freezer may help in your collection
- 13. Place collection in storage container.
- 14. Power off Rosin Control Box if your pressing time is over. Repeat steps 3-12 to continue working.
