2015 EDEN VALLEY RIESLING

The Blewitt Springs Estate label was created as a tribute to the first Patritti vineyard purchased and planted in the McLaren Vale region, the Blewitt Springs Vineyard. Its fruit has been a mainstay of Patritti table wines for over five decades. Similarly, this range provides wines of ever-reliable quality and excellent value for money.

REGION

Eden Valley is located in the cooler part of the Mount Lofty Ranges. Characterised by a higher altitude (380 - 550 metres), cool climate and ancient soils, it is known for producing elegant wines that display wonderful aromatics and complexity. The soil types vary within the region ranging from sandy loam to clay loam littered with gravel.

VINTAGE

A near perfect growing season and vintage led to an exceptional vintage in the Eden Valley region. Winter rains followed by a mild spring and early summer provided ideal conditions for vine flowering and fruit set. January was dry with hot winds threatening to rob the vines of vital moisture, but relief came in the form of rain and persistently cool temperatures for the remainder of the month. The mild weather remained throughout vintage resulting in fruit with high natural acidity and incredible flavour and colour concentration.

TASTING COMMENTS

Very pale straw in colour this wine displays all the hallmarks of a classic Eden Valley Riesling. Distinct aromas of lemon, lime and fresh citrus zest leap from the glass. Crisp and refreshing, the palate is more lime and lemon with a floral citrus blossom note. Delicately styled, the acid is cleansing with a dry finish.
