FRONTIGNAC ADELAIDE HILLS 2016

The Blewitt Springs Estate label was created as a tribute to the first Patritti vineyard purchased and planted in the McLaren Vale region, the Blewitt Springs Vineyard. It's fruit has been the mainstay of Patritti table wines for over five decades. Similarly, this range provides wines of ever-reliable quality and excellent value for money.

REGION

The Adelaide Hills wine region has a reputation for producing some of Australia's most exciting cool climate wines. With an average around 600 metres the climate is significantly cooler than the neighbouring areas. Cool, dry summers and an autumn ripening period produce a balanced fruit flavour profile and natural acidity.

VINTAGE

The season started mild with below average rainfall before well timed rain in January. Yields were above average across most varieties with whites from this vintage showing ideal fruit flavour and acid balance. 2016 is considered by many to be the best 'all-round' vintage for some time.

TASTING COMMENTS

This aromatic white is made from the oldest and most distinguished of the muscat grape varieties. Lifted aromas of musk with floral notes rise from the glass. The palate is more musk with rose water and citrus, and shows natural grape sweetness and cleansing acidity.
