



# BLEWITT SPRINGS ESTATE

## CHARDONNAY ADELAIDE HILLS 2017

*The Blewitt Springs Estate label was created as a tribute to the first Patritti vineyard purchased and planted in the McLaren Vale region, the Blewitt Springs Vineyard. It's fruit has been the mainstay of Patritti table wines for over five decades. Similarly, this range provides wines of ever-reliable quality and excellent value for money.*

### REGION

The Adelaide Hills wine region has a reputation for producing some of Australia's most exciting cool climate wines. With an average around 600 metres the climate is significantly cooler than the neighbouring areas. Cool, dry summers and an autumn ripening period produce a balanced fruit flavour profile and natural acidity.

### VINTAGE

Spring was cold and wet with the Adelaide Hills receiving its highest annual rainfall since 1992. Moist soils meant flower development was delayed and the catalyst for a late vintage. Warm, dry conditions with a few bursts of heat through the ripening period and into autumn allowed fruit to develop full colour with good flavour characteristics.

### TASTING COMMENTS

The colour is straw with green-gold tints. Fresh aromas of apple and pear flow through to the palate where spicy notes add interest and complexity. Cleansing acid exhilarates the taste buds and enhances the flavours before a crisp, mouthwatering finish.
