ROSÉ MCLAREN VALE 2018

The Blewitt Springs Estate label was created as a tribute to the first Patritti vineyard purchased and planted in the McLaren Vale region, the Blewitt Springs Vineyard. It's fruit has been the mainstay of Patritti table wines for over five decades. Similarly, this range provides wines of ever-reliable quality and excellent value for money.

REGION

McLaren Vale enjoys a reputation for producing high quality Shiraz and Grenache along with some alternative varietals from Italy and Spain. Elevation peaks at 350 metres along the Sellicks foothills with these vineyards influenced by the cooler gully winds making them ideal for white wine and cooler climate varieties. Majority of vineyards are located on gently undulating land with strong coastal influences. The Mediterranean climate is characterised by moderate winters, warm summers and predictable winter rainfall.

VINTAGE

Winter and spring rainfall ensured soil moisture was adequate through the dry growing season and vines were in good health leading into summer. January and February were warm and dry allowing the grapes to ripen over an extended period leading to fruit packed with varietal characteristics and flavour.

TASTING COMMENTS

Sourced from premium vineyards in the world-renowned McLaren Vale region this rosé is bright medium pink in colour. The nose is a lifted blend of watermelon, cherries, strawberries and rose petals. The palate is quite soft with flavours of sweet red cherries, strawberry and rosewater. A touch of sweetness leave the palate balanced and refreshing.
