Lesson One: *Celebrating Our Special Selves*

Objectives: The student will be able to:

- Discuss respect for differences.
- Identify his or her special qualities.

- Define feelings as natural emotions that are neither right nor wrong.
- Differentiate feelings and actions or behaviors.

- List friendly behaviors.

- Identify warning signs (physical sensations) of anger.
