

TOP BAR HIVE NUCLEUS BOX



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


TOOLS NEEDED:




PARTS INCLUDED:

- A** 2 SHORT END BOARD
- B** 2 LONG SIDE BOARDS
(ONE WITH AN ENTRANCE)
- C** BOTTOM BOARD
- D** 1 LID
- E** 16 1 5/8" SCREWS



Start by attaching a long board to one of the short ends using the pre-drilled holes. Since the nucleus has angled sides, we find it easiest to do this on a table edge so your hand can freely drill without running out of space. It also helps to do the narrowest part, the bottom of the nuc, first. Attach the other end in the same way.



Now attach the bottom board.
VOILÀ! You have a complete nucleus box!

A NOTE ON TUNG OIL:



Do not apply until you are finished assembling your hive! Tung oil can only be applied to the outside of your hive, never ever the inside or inside joints—the smell could make your bees flee!
