Materials:

2 tags	Bead Gallery® aqua glass rondelle 4x6mm
1 tag	Bead Gallery® glass gold luster 3x6mm rondelle
1 tag	Bead Gallery® aqua 8mm cut luster glass round
3 Tags	Bead Gallery® glass round gold tone 3mm
1 Tag	Bead Gallery® green iris glass small rondelle
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® green iris 3mm round
2 Tags	Bead Gallery® amber glass 4x5mm oval
1	Bead Gallery® gold iris quartz crystal stone spike
1	Bead Gallery® acrylic druzy in metal slider
1	Charm Gallery® gold tone feather charm
1	Charm Gallery® gold tone North Star charm
1	Charm Gallery® gold tone star charm
1	Charm Gallery® gold tone Celtic charm
1	Bead Landing™ gold tone 2" beaded head pin
110"	Stretch Magic® .5mm beading cord

Tools:

Beadalon® wire nippers
Super glue
Bead Bugs®

Level of difficulty (Beginner)

Time – Less than 10 minutes per bracelet

Tip: Stretch cord before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the shape of your bracelet.

Measure your wrist and adjust bead length as necessary.

Aqua Rondelle and North Star charm Bracelets

Instructions:

1. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
2. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
3. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
4. String 7" aqua glass rondelle 4x6mm beads.
5. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
6. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
7. Repeat steps 1-6 for 2nd bracelet.
8. Attach North Star charm to 1 of the bracelets.

Gold Luster Rondelle bracelet

Instructions:

9. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
10. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
11. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
12. String 6 ½" of gold luster rondelles 3x6mm.
13. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
14. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

Aqua 8mm Cut Luster Wing Charm Bracelet

Instructions:

15. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
16. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
17. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
18. String 7" aqua 8mm cut luster glass beads.
19. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
20. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
21. Attach feather charm to bracelet.

Round Gold 3mm Bracelet and Star Charm Bracelet

Instructions:

22. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
23. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
24. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
25. String 7" round gold 3mm beads.
26. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
27. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
28. Repeat steps 22-27 for 2nd bracelet.
29. Attach star charm to 1 bracelet.

Green Iris 3mm Bracelet and Celtic charm bracelet

Instructions:

30. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
31. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
32. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
33. String 7" green iris 3mm beads.

34. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
35. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
36. Repeat steps 30-35 for 2nd bracelet.
37. Attach Celtic charm to 1 bracelet.

Green Iris Druzy Slider Bracelet

Instructions:

38. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
39. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
40. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
41. String 7" small green iris beads.
42. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
43. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
44. Using 2" beaded head pin, string 1 hole inside druzy slider and form a simple loop.
45. Attach loop to bracelet.

Amber Glass Oval Bracelet

Instructions:

46. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
47. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
48. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
49. String 7" amber glass ovals.
50. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
51. Hide knot inside of closest bead.

Amber Glass Oval Bracelet With Gold Spike

Instructions:

52. Cut 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
53. Stretch cord well before stringing your beads. This will help maintain the bracelets shape in the future.
54. Attach Bead Bug to end of 10" of Stretch Magic cord.
55. String 7" amber glass ovals and gold spike.
56. Remove Bead Bug, bring both ends together and form an overhand knot. Pull tight. Make a second overhand knot and put a drop of glue between knots. Pull tight.
57. Hide knot inside of closest bead.
