 - Workload Modeling: resource-loaded schedule to forecast aggregated workloads: add the 5 A's: Activities, Availabilities of Resources, Assignments, Assignment Units, Assignment Effort
 - **Cost Modeling**: most advanced schedule to forecast cost: add the 6 C's: *Capital, Charge Accounts, Charge Rates, Cost & Material Resources, Cost Accrual, Charge Rate Escalation*
- DCMA 14 checks from the Defense Contract Manufacturing Association (DCMA)
- GAO 33 checks from the USA General Accountability Office's Schedule Assessment Guide

FSA appears on the right-hand side of your screen: You can see it AND improve your schedule side-by-side. Each check passes \checkmark or fails \varkappa . When you click \varkappa , FSA adjusts the screen and highlights where you can improve your schedule:
