

Official "Puck Luck" Rules

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1) Each goal should be placed approximately 20 feet apart, facing each other.
- 2) For increased difficulty, the goals can be spread further apart.
- 3) Game can be played either 1v1 or 2v2
- 4) If the game is being playing 2v2, one player from each team must stand behind one goal while the other two players start behind the other goal.

SCORING SYSTEM:

There are three different ways that you can score in Puck Luck

The first option is to rip a saucey biscuit into the rectangular slot right above the tender's head with one point awarded to you or your team for achieving this feat.

If your team is down and you need a mount a comeback, fire one five-hole on the goalie for a two-point advantage.

Finally, the most challenging achievement is to huck a hip-high sauce and have your teammate try and tip it into the top of the goal for a big three-point push.

RULES:

Each teammate, standing at opposite sides, gets one attempt (2 total) to score in either of the three slots before the other team gets their two attempts.

In order to determine which team shoots first, one player from each team starts with a puck and they simultaneously shoot for the slot above the goalie's head. If neither score, the other players take their attempts. The first team to "break the ice" starts the game shooting first. The teammate of the player who shoots the puck has an unlimited range to try and tip the puck into the top of the goal.

In the event that the puck successfully enters the goal and pops out into the air, the player of the teammate who shot the puck can tap it into any of the three slots for an additional point. *The puck must be knocked out of the air, and not shot in from the ground*

No player can touch the goal to help the puck enter the slots.

If the puck touches the ground at any time before entering the goal, the puck is dead.

Puck Luck is played to 21, but you must win by 2 or more points.

8 Saucer King rubber pucks

Hockey sticks not included
