

## **CONTENTS OF PACKAGE:**

- 2 **SAUCEOFF** Shooting Boards
- 2 Mini Shooting Pads
- 4 **SAUCEOFF** Bean Bag Pucks
- 8 GONGSHOW Floater Pucks (4 per team)
- Carrying Case

## SETUP:

GONGSHOW SAUCEOFF can be played (1 on 1), in teams of 2 vs 2, or you can practice your sauce accuracy by yourself!

- Each side will have one **SAUCEOFF BOARD** and one mini shooting pad. It is recommended that the distance between the boards be 25-30 feet but you can adjust this based on preference/skill level
- IF PLAYING 2 vs 2:
- Your teammate stands at the opposite SAUCEOFF BOARD across from you
- Place the 8 GONGSHOW floater pucks at whatever end will start first (4 pucks per turn per team) or 4 Bean Bag Pucks
- IF PLAYING 1 vs 1:
- Your opponent stands at the opposite **SAUCEOFF BOARD** across from you

#### RULES:

- Whatever team is wearing a **GONGSHOW** hat gets first turn
- If both teams are wearing a **GONGSHOW** hat, each team gets 1 shot. Continue alternating shots until a team scores. That team will go first to begin the game.
- Each "turn" consists of 4 shots
- The shooting board has 3 "1 Goal" spaces and 2 "2 goal spaces". The first team to reach 21 goals wins the game
- The winning team **MUST** get to exactly 21 goals- if the team goes over 21, their score is bumped back down to 15 and they will continue from there
- If the losing team is within 10 goals, they get a "LAST CHANCE" shot. If they make this shot in any of the goal spaces, they can continue shooting until they miss, or tie the game at 21
- If a game is tied at 21, it moves into sudden death. The rules remain the same except the first team to 5 goals wins. The
- "LAST CHANCE" rule remains in play for the duration of overtime until a winner is established
- If your shot looks like it is headed wide, your teammate may tip it to try and direct it in. If it goes into a goal hole, add an extra goal for the tip!
- Only your teammate may tip your shot. You cannot tip an opponents shot!
- Only **GONGSHOW** floater pucks may be used. The **GONGSHOW SAUCEOFF** Game is not meant to be used with real pucks and this voids the warranty
- Soft hands only! Only saucer passes, no hard shots of any kind!

## **HELPFUL TIPS:**

- ullet Make sure your boards are in a very solid position. There is nothing worse than a moving **SAUCEOFF** board
- Keep in mind that if you're a right handed shot you'll want to be more in line with the opposing board when you're on the left side of the board and vice-versa if you're left-handed.
- You don't have to sauce directly into the goal holes to score! A good strategy is to aim your sauce higher up on the board and let the puck slide down into one of the goal slots!
- Do not use real pucks! They will damage the game board.\*
