Toddler Beanie - Plain



Supplies: Size 4mm needles + 1 ball 50g Wild Earth Natural Undyed NZ Wool

Cast on 68 stitches (to make a smaller version just cast on less stitches)

Row 1: Knit Row 2: Purl

Continue for 43 Rows finish on a purl row

Row 44: Knit 2 together until end of row (34 stitches)

Row 45: Purl until end of row

Row 46: Knit 2 together until end of row (17 stitches)

Row 47: Purl until end of row

Row 48: Knit 2 together until end of row (8 stitches)

Cut the yarn leaving a tail of about 30cm to sew up the beanie. Thread the yarn through the eye of a large knitting needle to sew up the beanie. Thread the needle through the remaining stitches on the needle and pull tightly to gather the top of the beanie. Sew up the beanie using an edge to edge flat seam.
