Day 3 self bandage

Case: Male, 49 year old, type 2 diabetic, spider bite 4 years prior followed by gradual swelling of left limb. Hardened skin around ankle, fluid is soft, bell like effect in leg.

Application: Bandage at clinic after MLD, instructed in technique. Bandaged 1 \times 24 hours, then night time \times 2. Instructed in deep abdominal breathing + SLD
