

Cuddly Sock CAT

with optional warming pouch





SUPPLIES

- 1 PAIR OF SOCKS
- POLY-FIL
- SCISSORS
- NEEDLE AND THREAD (SEWING MACHINE IS HELPFUL)
- 2 BUTTONS FOR EYES
- EMBROIDERY FLOSS FOR NOSE, MOUTH AND WHISKERS
- OPTIONAL: FABRIC GLUE, FELT AND RICE

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Steps:

KEY:  SEW
 CUT

1. Turn both socks wrong-side out and lay with heel facing up (see Pic 1).
2. Mark sewing lines (see Pic 2).
3. Cut as illustrated in Pic 2 (save portion of sock above cat head if doing heat pouch).
4. Stuff body, head and tail, then sew closed.
5. Pin and sew into place (see Pic 3).
6. Mark eyes, nose and mouth onto cat (see Pic 4).
7. Sew eyes, nose and mouth onto cat (see Pic 5).

TO MAKE OPTIONAL WARMING POUCH:

1. Slightly fold over the raw edge of saved tube portion and glue into place using fabric glue, then let dry.
2. Cut felt into desired dimensions to create a heat packet (see Pic 6). Mine was 3 1/2" x 3 1/2".
3. Slide the tube onto the cat, over it's center (see Pic 7).
4. To use, heat packet for small increments (10-15 seconds) to prevent burning and getting too hot. Then, slide into the tube portion on the cat. Cuddle away!
